"Australia will be the next one," the report quotes him as saying.

Currently the Etihad Holidays UK site offers packages from various airports in Britain and Ireland to destinations such as Dubai, Vietnam, the Maldives, Seychelles, Sri Lanka and Abu Dhabi, priced in British pounds inclusive of EY airfares.

Baumgartner also foreshadowed strengthening links between the Etihad Guest loyalty program and Virgin Australia's Velocity scheme.

He said Etihad Guest has a healthy membership base in Australia, and while there is already close co-operation with Velocity, the schemes are looking at "how much more can be done".

Recently, Virgin Australia and Singapore Airlines significantly enhanced the cooperation between their respective loyalty programs (*TD* 25 Sep).

Jetstar cutting Newcastle

JETSTAR is reducing its flights at Newcastle Airport north of Sydney, saying the move is due to failure to reach agreement with the airport operator over pricing.

A total of seven weekly return services have been suspended three from Newcastle to the Gold Coast and four to Melbourne.

The suspension is for a six week period from 14 Dec.

A Jetstar spokesperson confirmed the move, saying it was necessary "due to the uncertainty caused by Newcastle Airport's proposal to increase charges by more than 50%.

"We are continuing to review our existing Newcastle schedule in light of increasing airport charges that will make some services unviable," the spokesperson added.

The fees dispute, which follows the expiration of a 10-year pricing agreement set up when Jetstar was in its infancy, has led to an increasingly bitter war of words, with Tourism Hunter chair Will Creedon saying "all we're asking Jetstar is to pay their fair share."

He said the airport has expanded over the last decade to meet Jetstar's needs, and suggested that there may be "others waiting in the wings to take on the time slots that are made available by Jetstar's departure".

Newcastle Airport ceo Paul Hughes said the pricing changes amount to \$1.70 per passenger and urged Jetstar to negotiate.

Helloworld UBS shift

MERCHANT bank UBS AG has lodged a "notice of change of interests of substantial holder" in relation to its stake in Helloworld Limited.

Previously UBS had interests in 44.8% of Helloworld, with the firm's voting power now reduced to 17.89%, the notice states.

This is because UBS Australia Holdings Limited "is no longer associated with Europe Voyager NV" due to a co-ordination deed filed on 01 Oct 2010 having been terminated effective 30 Sep 2014.

No money has changed hands as a result, with the Europe Voyager holding company continuing to hold its current Helloworld stake.

Jetstar Japan/AA c's

AMERICAN Airlines is seeking approval from US authorities to begin codesharing on flights operated by Jetstar Japan.

Initially, the codeshare will cover Jetstar Japan's domestic services on trunk routes, AA/GK said.








Munro voices concern

ACCOMMODATION Association of Australia ceo Richard Munro has labelled the ACCC's approval of the Expedia plan to purchase Wotif.com as "bad news for [the] accommodation industry".

Munro's comments echo those of the Australian Hotel Association and Tourism Accommodation Australia, who yesterday warned of 85% of Australia's OTA market will be controlled by two multinational giants when the Wotif acquisition deal is finalised.

"With less competition, higher commission fees and reduced hotel margins, this cannot be good news for consumers," he added.

KUNMING in China's southwest Yunnan Province has joined the list of fellow Chinese cities offering 72-hour visa-free passes to tourists to enjoy the city.

Nationals from 51 countries including Australia can now enter the city visa-free provided they hold a valid ticket for air travel on to their next country in 72 hours.

Kunming joins Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou, Chengdu, Chongqing, Shenyang, Dalian, Xi'an and Guilin in the scheme.

BRITISH Airways commenced A380 services between London **Heathrow and Washington Dulles** overnight, at the same time debuting a new First & Business class lounge at the US capital.

Faster 737 build rate

BOEING says it will ramp up the rate of production for its 737 program from the current rate of 42 aircraft per month to 52 in 2018 due to "strong market demand from customers".

Currently, Boeing has 266 customers globally for the singleaisle aircraft, with amassed orders of over 12,100 units.

The aircraft manufacturer is already planning to boost the 737s production rate to 47 planes per month in 2017.

The newly timed AC548 ex Vancouver will launch on 26 Oct, departing at 0915 and landing in Newark at 1729.


