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SYD takes control of T₃

TODAY'S landmark deal between Qantas and Sydney Airport (TD breaking news) will see the airport take control of Terminal 3 almost four years ahead of schedule.

In its half year annual results, also released today, SYD said T3 would become a "common use terminal" by 30 Jun 2019, giving it access to "new passenger-related aeronautical and retail revenue streams".

Qantas signed a 30 year lease on the terminal in 1989, and will receive \$535 million from the airport in return for handing T3 back early.

Sydney Airport ceo Kerrie Mather said the outcome was the result of a long term engagement with Qantas, focused on achieving a win-win result.

"We are excited to now have 100% of our terminal footprint. to work closely with Qantas and from 2019 other airline partners using Terminal 3, and we look forward to continuing to provide passengers with a world class experience," Mather said.

She said taking over T3 from Qantas was required for SYD's future expansion plans and the integration of terminals.

Four years ago (TD 05 Dec 2011), the airport announced an "exciting new vision" which would see it transform into two airline alliance-based precincts with integrated international, domestic and regional services.

While this is still a work in progress, taking control of T3 gives SYD significant flexibility.

Qantas ceo Alan Joyce said the deal secured QF's long term position and ensured it would have priority usage as the "primary airline customer" of T3.

Border Big Brother plan

THE Australian Government has put out to tender the contract for a system integration partner for a new smarter and faster Traveller Border Clearance Platform (TBCP), planned to be introduced in 2018.

It follows the creation of the Australian Border Force on 01 Jul.

The revamped TBCP will see the extension of biometric identification processes to the majority of air and sea travellers, tender documents indicate.

Phase one of the contract is scheduled to commence in Dec and is for development services to integrate the TBCP with multiple Dept of Immigration and Border Security systems.

It comes as the Department "needs to respond to growth forecasts for the number of travellers crossing Australian borders over the next 15 years".

Based on current projections, traveller numbers are expected to reach 110 million movements within that time period.

The Dept is looking to adopt an "intelligence-led, risk-based approach to border control", that will involve "low contact, selfprocessed border transactions" for legitimate travellers.

"Implementing a modern, sophisticated and fit for purpose border clearance solution for travellers is expected to provide significant positive outcomes."

New capabilities flagged should be able to manage a traveller's

end-to-end journey across the Australian border, commencing when they are first identified as intending to travel & concluding when they cross the border.

Known legitimate travellers will be matched to existing biographic and/or biometric id information, or will have a new ID created.

"To facilitate this, a process will commence for each traveller, providing capture of & access to all journey and travel information permissible under international agreements and legislation," the documents state.

MU pulls out of JHK

CHINA Eastern has pulled the pin on its planned joint venture with Qantas for the launch of a Jetstar Hong Kong offshoot.

According to Fairfax which cited a Hong Kong Stock Exchange announcement by MU, the carrier said its board has authorised "the termination of the proposed establishment of Jetstar Hong Kong" and its wind up.

Jetstar Hong Kong has three shareholders, China Eastern, Qantas and Shun Tak Holdings.

"The board deeply regrets that the application for a air transport licence made by Jetstar Hong Kong has been refused," the Chinese carrier said.

New Melbourne Airport terminal

MELBOURNE Airport this morning opened the doors of its new Terminal 4 - the first airport terminal in the Asia-Pacific region to offer a completely self-service check-in operation.

There are already several retailers in the level 1 departure lounge, with the staged opening set to see more than 30 fashion and convenience stores added.

Tigerair flight TT206 departed at 0645 for Sydney, with the Virgin Australia offshoot to continue operating from T4 while its existing Tullamarine facilities are refurbished.

Etihad to Stansted

ETIHAD has scheduled a one-off charter flight from Abu Dhabi to London Stansted Airport, with the service to operate on 01 Sep.

According to GDS flight information, the AUH-STN flight will utilise an A330-300 aircraft.

Jetstar and Regional Express will also move into the new terminal in the coming months.

Melbourne Airport operations chief Lorie Argus said today marked an important milestone in the two year construction phase of Terminal 4, which has been built while the airport continued operating 24/7.

The terminal currently features ten self service check-in kiosks and automated bag drops.

Tigerair said the new facilities provide a "vastly improved customer experience" at its busiest domestic port.

TT check-in staff at T4 will be completely mobile using the Max Airport iPad app (TD 07 May), with the carrier's ceo Rob Sharp saying "as technology continues to evolve we will never be complacent...we already have many more customer facing innovations in the pipeline".

INDIAN domestic carrier IndiGo has bedded down a commitment with aircraft manufacturer Airbus for 250 A320neo family aircraft.

The order was provisionally inked last year (*TD* 16 Oct 14) but was formally signed yesterday, India's Independence Day.

Four years ago IndiGo agreed to purchase 180 A320neo jets, with the now firm additional order taking its total tally to 530 A320s.

FAA slaps Southwest

BUDGET US carrier Southwest Airlines is facing a civil penalty of US\$325,000 from the FAA for operating a damaged Boeing 737 with a temporary repair more than 24,800 times.

The Federal Aviation Admin allege the aircraft had an approx 9" crease in the aluminium skin with a temporary fix recorded as a "permanent repair".

It's understood the jet sustained the fuselage damage in May 2002 when it received the patch.

The agency claims Southwest operated the plane on 24,831 flights without performing the periodic inspections necessary for the temporary repair, as well as a further 4,831 flights beyond the threshold by which it was required to have carried out the permanent repair.



AFTA update

From AFTA's chief executive, Jayson Westbury

SEEMS that things in Canberra have moved on quickly with the new speaker (mentioned in my column in *TD* last week) installed and taking the big chair in the House of Representatives and making his mark on the Parliament.

Meanwhile first world problems are getting a solid run both in the House of Representatives and the media.

I am actually in Canberra for a few days and the lively debate around same-sex marriage has dominated discussions. In fact yesterday Warren Entsch MP (LNP member for Leichhardt in Queensland) introduced and spoke to a private members bill in favour of same-sex marriage.

Parliament has had several of these private members bills over the years but this is the first time a bill of this nature has come from a Coalition MP. The process with this is a little complicated and it is very unlikely that the bill introduced yesterday will result in a vote by members of Parliament at this time.

However, it is very clear that same-sex marriage will be a front and centre issue of the next federal election and there is no doubt that one way or another the issue will find its way into Parliament in the next year or so. Regardless of your own view on this issue, I am sure we will see this bubble along for some time yet and in the end one way or another the Australia Parliament will bring this matter to a close with legislation.

I think it is an important issue for the country to resolve and hopefully our elected officials can articulate an appropriate path for us all to consider and then for the parliament to vote upon.

Canberra at work – it is nice to see them actually working on policy rather than on each other for a change.

\$4.6m for WAITOC

WA tourism minister Kim Hames has announced a new partnership between Tourism Western Australia and the WA Indigenous Tourism Operators Council (WAITOC), underpinning a business development and marketing program "to support a sustainable Aboriginal Tourism Sector".

Enabled by the government's Royalties for Regions program, the new \$4.6m Aboriginal Tourism Development Program will see about 20 businesses selected for product and business development assistance, while associated marketing will aim to lift awareness of Aboriginal tourism experiences across the state.

Bangkok bombing

THE Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade this morning reissued its travel advice for Thailand, after a bomb exploded in central Bangkok's Chidlom district.

The blast went off around 7pm at the Erawan Shrine, a Hindu temple adjacent to a busy intersection, with local reports confirming at least 22 dead and many more injured.

Officials have confirmed that some Chinese tourists who had travelled to Thailand from the Philippines are among those killed in the blast.




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
