



PER urges bilateral rethink

PERTH Airport has suggested that it be removed as a "Major Gateway" in future Australian bilateral air services agreements, in a controversial submission to the Productivity Commission made public last week.

The submission says there is a strong case for the policy change, which would open up the WA capital to more international airlines because they would not be restricted from flying to Perth.

Currently, many bilateral aviation agreements put a cap on the number of flights which can be operated between Australia and other countries but usually this cap only applies to services to designated Major Gateways which include Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane and Perth.

Flights to other ports such as Cairns, Darwin and Adelaide are generally unrestricted.

Major Gateway, including the fact that just 7% of international seats at PER are provided by Australian carriers - making it dependent on foreign airlines having sufficient bilateral rights to boost capacity.

The airport argues there would not be a material impact on Australian carriers since PER cannot be realistically used to access east coast markets.

At the moment, carriers entering the market have to take into account bilateral capacity when considering Perth flights, but if the proposal was implemented the only criteria is whether the airlines believe a PER service would be commercially successful relative to other destinations, the submission concludes.

EY Sydney reduction

ETIHAD Airways has scheduled a reduction in A380 services to Sydney between 01 Jun-26 Jul. according to agent GDS displays.

Flights from EY's Abu Dhabi hub using the superjumbo will drop from daily to six weekly, with the outbound Sat morning flight from Sydney scrapped.

Further adjustments will see EY switch aircraft on EY450 ex AUH from 777-300ER to A340-600s on Sun (EY451 ex SYD on Mon).



Fuel to drive airline boom

AIRLINES around the world are set to report sharp increases in their profits as a result of plummeting fuel prices, according to ratings agency Moody's.

In a report issued yesterday, Moody's said it doesn't expect carriers to share much of the savings with customers because they are in jurisdictions without regulated fuel surcharges - such as Australia and the USA.

"Capacity increases in their home markets will be more modest than those in developing markets and stable GDP growth will support steady demand, minimising the need to meaningfully lower fares," the report said.

Moody's said it expects airlines to use the "windfall" to reduce debt, pay for new aircraft and improve shareholder returns, rather than "wage market share battles".

Fuel surcharges are likely to decline in some markets such as Japan and China where they are regulated by governments.

The news isn't so good in the Asia-Pacific region, however, where Moody's said it expects a "flood of capacity from start-up airlines to outstrip demand," which will in turn impacts yields for the next few years.



MEL, SYD Dec traffic

MELBOURNE Airport has today reported an 8% year-on-year rise in international pax traffic for the calendar year, with 8.05 million movements.

The Victorian capital's growth rate was more than double that of Sydney Airport (2.8%), however the volume of movements at SYD was far greater at over 13.1m.

On the domestic front, MEL's passenger traffic tally was up 2% to 23.5m while SYD traffic rose a fraction over 1% to 25.3m.

Melbourne's highest inbound growth market during Dec 2014 came from Japan (up 58%), China (24.5%) and South Korea (23%).

The top foreign nationalities travelling through SYD in Dec were Kiwis, Chinese and Brits.

Fiji Air plan Asia expansion

TOKYO or Shanghai will be added to the Fiji Airways global route network from next year upon the carrier taking delivery of its next A330 aircraft, FJ has said.

The carrier is now weighing



up which of the two potential routes will offer the best flight connections both within Fiji, the rest of its network and with other partner carriers.

"What we are doing now is trying to start discussions with potential airline partners because we don't just want to fly to Tokyo or to Shanghai without any airline partner," FJ ceo Stefan Pichler told the Fiji Broadcasting Corporation.

"I think Air Pacific has done this in the past with Tokyo and always lost money. We don't want to do trial and error, when we do something it has to work."

Currently, only Hong Kong exists on Fiji Airways' Asian route map, however it has operated services to Japan in the past.


FJ will take delivery of its fourth A330 aircraft, a leased Dash-300 variant, in Dec (TD 05 Jan).

FORMER Australian procyclist Stuart O'Grady has established a new small group touring venture to enable the public to get up close with elite-level cyclists.


Dubbed Stuart O'Grady Cycling, the business can arrange tours anywhere in Australia, packaged tours around special events and one-off experiences.

DFAT advises that the current warning level for Australians in Malawi remains at "Exercise normal safety precautions".

Shangri-La opening
