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Virgin on track for black

VIRGIN Australia this morning reported an \$8.5 million "underlying profit before tax" for the three months to 30 Sep, with ceo John Borghetti saying based on current market conditions the airline is "on track to return to profitability for the 2016 financial year".

The quarterly result is a hefty \$53.5 million improvement over the prior corresponding period - and even better when the performance of Tigerair is taken into account.

Statutory after-tax profit for the three month period was \$1.7 million, with Borghetti saying yield continued to increase while underlying costs declined.

"This result reflects our continued success in driving revenue per available seat kilometre and yield growth while controlling costs," Borghetti said.

Tigerair recorded a \$400,000 EBIT for the quarter, an improvement of \$20.2 million.

Air NZ buys 15 ATRs

AIR New Zealand today announced it would purchase 15 new ATR72-600 aircraft to operate its regional services.

11 of the new planes will replace its existing ATR72-500 fleet, while four will allow for further network growth.

The aircraft will begin arriving from late next year.

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Denpasar still closed

BALI'S Denpasar Airport will remain closed as the Mount Rinjani ash cloud continues to make flying conditions unsafe. Jetstar has cancelled all flights to and from Bali for today and some tomorrow & VA has cancelled flights for today and tomorrow.

St Giles debuts in Australia

MALAYSIAN hospitality company St Giles Hotel Group has entered the Australian market with the opening of The Tank Stream Hotel in Sydney last night.

The 280-room four-star hotel sits on the corner of Pitt and Hunter street and offers an inclusive "one rate" concept. "You don't have to worry about wi-fi or taking a bottle of water or juice, everything's included," Tan

Boon Lee, executive director of property development group, IGB Corporation Berhad told *Travel Daily* at the launch.

"We don't like to pay a bill by credit card & then be told I've got to pay 2%. It's just a bad taste in your mouth," Tan said.

During the week, the hotel is targeting the business corporate traveller and is hoping to attract some interstate and overseas guests on the weekend.

Tan said the The Tank Stream Hotel complements the other hotels in the area.

"We are offering a different product and we're not competing at that five star level with Intercontinental & Four Seasons."

As for future plans in Australia, Tan was staying tight-lipped, saying the group will concentrate on the "gateway cities of the world" with existing properties in London, New York, Manila and Kuala Lumpur - more on **page 5**.

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NZ United agents to First

NEW Zealand's First Travel Group has confirmed its numbers will surge by 37 extra member agencies as part of the mass defection from Helloworld's United Travel Group (TD 02 Oct).

The resignations from United follow Helloworld's move to establish the *helloworld* retail brand across the Tasman, which had been strongly opposed by the majority of United Travel

members, leading to the exodus.

The group will join First in Apr 2016 once their existing agreements expire, almost doubling the size of the network which currently comprises "over 40 long established, independently owned professional travel businesses".

According to the First Travel Group website members currently transact more than NZ\$500 million annually, enabling them to access "fantastic tier one deals with all major suppliers".

"Due to our member owned co-operative policy, final details will be determined over the next few months once we have taken the opportunity to consult with all of our stakeholders," said First Travel Group chairman Warwick Beaton.

QF BNE-SYD boost

QANTAS has boosted capacity on the key Sydney-Brisbane route with three new morning flights in each direction Mon-Wed and five more evening flights each Mon, Tue, Wed, Fri and Sat.

More seats have also been added via the deployment of wide-bodied A330 aircraft at peak times, with all of the additional capacity now available in GDS.

Perth hotel site sold

SINGAPORE-BASED Global Premium Hotels has paid almost \$24 million for a development site on Perth's St Georges Terrace.

The publicly listed company currently operates 23 hotels in Singapore, two under the Parc Sovereign brand and the remainder as Fragrance Hotels.

Maldives emergency

THE Maldivian government has declared a 30-day "state of emergency" effective immediately, citing ongoing national security and safety concerns.

The Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade has reissued its travel advice for the Indian Ocean nation, warning Australian travellers to exercise a high degree of caution in the capital, Male, due to the "possibility of civil unrest and large protests".

DFAT has not changed the overall level of the advice, with the rest of the Maldives remaining at the lowest "exercise normal safety precautions" level.

Dubai Garden Inns

HILTON Worldwide has launched its Hilton Garden Inn brand into the UAE with the debut of the 183-room Hilton Garden Inn Dubai Al Muraqabat.

A further 552 rooms will be added over the next two months, with the 182-room Hilton Garden Inn Dubai Al Mina and the 370-room Hilton Garden Inn Mall of the Emirates.

NEW Yorkers had a fleeting glimpse of the future yesterday when an Australian "rocket man" wearing a jetpack made the first ever "controlled and sustained flight" around the iconic Statue of Liberty.

Technology and mining entrepreneur David Mayman - whose exploits have been documented in the Discovery Channel movie *Rocket Compulsion* - was wearing a JB-19 jetpack which his company, Jetpack Aviation, has developed in conjunction with "legendary Hollywood inventor" Nelson Tyler - who also happens to have won 3 Academy Awards.

The jetpack, which operates using a miniature jet turbine, has been approved for flight by the US Federal Aviation Administration.

"We have just proved that personal flight is a reality," a thrilled Mayman said.
