







# Value World Travel collapse

**SYDNEY-BASED** Value World Travel has been placed into administration, with the Parramatta travel agency set to be wound up by its creditors.

Daniel Civil from insolvency specialists Jirsch Sutherland has been appointed as external administrator of the company, with the Value World Travel website now offline and phone calls remaining unanswered.

Value World Travel Pty Ltd was founded in 2009, and promoted itself heavily via billboards in Sydney's western suburbs, offering "cheap flights to India".

The company's 100 ordinary shares are held by Ariik Awan Lueth of Blacktown, NSW who is also the company's sole director and shareholder - but he only took on the roles two weeks ago.

He took over on 29 Oct from previous director and secretary, Pradeep Upadhyay of Constitution Hill in NSW, who is the registered owner of the valueworldtravel.com.au website.

Previous shareholders include Neni Tiwari, whose address is the same as that of the company.

Tiwari was banned from being a company director in Jan this year for failing to meet his legal obligations over the 2012 collapse of an insurance company called Value Greenslips Pty Ltd.

Although the Value World Travel Facebook page has been taken down, there are scores of negative Google reviews including one which indicates at least 200 people were denied boarding at Sydney Airport last week.

A number of customers are believed to be requesting credit card charge backs, with further details of major creditors expected to be revealed in the coming days.

AFTA has confirmed that the business was neither a member of the Federation, nor accredited under the ATAS scheme.

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## **SQ adds Dusseldorf**

**SINGAPORE** Airlines this morning announced the addition of non-stop flights from Singapore to Dusseldof, which will become SQ's third German port when the services debut in Jun 2016.

Subject to regulatory approval, SQ will operate its all-new Airbus A350-900 on the route three times per week.

### **Fast growing markets**

**VISITOR** numbers from Sri Lanka have increased by 26% in the last twelve months, making the country Australia's fastest growing source market.

According to an analysis of short term international arrivals following the monthly ABS arrival and departure figures (TD yesterday) by John O'Shea, Travel & Tourism Analyst with Bell Potter Securities, others in the top five fastest growing markets include Vietnam, China and the Philippines, all up 22%, as well as "other North-West Europe" which has grown 21% over the year.

O'Shea is one of the presenters at this weekend's Express Travel Group conference in Singapore.

# Domestic tourism "limbo"

**THE** Australian domestic tourism market is expected to "remain in limbo" over the next five years, according to a key report released today by consulting firm IBISWorld.

The Tourism in Australia industry report says the global financial crisis has limited the number of international travellers visiting Australia, but record numbers of Aussies took advantage of the high dollar to travel overseas.

Domestic tourism has grown, but remains weak relative to outbound as Australians have spent more time abroad - while aggressive local price competition has reduced profit margins.

completely negative, with strong growth in inbound tourism from Asia set to offset the weakness.

The report also confirms that the industry will exceed the lower end of the Tourism 2020 targets, with a prediction of industry revenue worth almost \$130 billion over the next five years.

The changing conditions in inbound tourism have reduced industry participation with smaller operators lacking scale and scope leaving the sector.

Those slow to target growing Asian tourism are also likely to be at risk, IBISWorld warned.

# **EK talking Turkey**

**EMIRATES** is expanding services to Istanbul, with a new daily flight between Dubai and the city's secondary Sabiha Gokcen airport.

The new SAW route will operate using Airbus A330-200 aircraft, with GDS screens indicating the flights will be designated as EK119/120 effective 15 Dec 2015.

Emirates also currently operates double daily 777-300ER services to Istanbul Ataturk airport (IST).

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# SQ to roll out inflight internet

**SINGAPORE** Airlines is set to deploy a range of passenger connectivity services across its fleet, including wi-fi and mobile phone text and data, after selecting the new SITAONAIR system powered by Inmarsat's GX

Expedia TAAP, that's

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Aviation satellite network. The high-speed internet

access service, underpinned by Honeywell JetWave hardware, is set to begin installation in the second half of 2016.

The third GX Aviation satellite was successfully launched in Aug "completing the constellation that provides consistent global coverage" with data speeds of up to 50Mbps to the aircraft.

SITAONAIR said there will be no difference between being in the air and on the ground in terms of internet speed, opening up a "whole new world of possibilities for the connected aircraft".

SQ's Boeing 777-300ER fleet will be the first aircraft type to be equipped with the system, followed by A380-800s and the carrier's new A350-900s.

## Delta adds MSP/RKV

**NEW** flights linking Minneapolis with the capital of Iceland will be introduced by Delta Air Lines.

The seasonal service to Reykjavik will debut on 26 May and will be DL's fifth European gateway from the 'Twin Cities', operating in partnership with Air France, KLM and Alitalia.

Flights will operate using Boeing 757-300 aircraft.

MEANWHILE, Delta will extend the season of its New York JFK-Reykjavik service from four to seven months, beginning 11 Feb.

Frequencies launch as thrice weekly, moving to daily in May.

#### **Record Aus Bali visits**

**AUSTRALIAN** visitor numbers to Bali set a new all time monthly record benchmark in Sep. topping the 100.000 mark for the first time in recorded history.

Preliminary data issued by Bali **Government Tourist Office shows** a whopping 100,406 Aussies arrived in the Indonesian holiday hub over the 30 day month.

The result is a vast improvement on the arrivals figure from the Australian market for the month prior, which saw numbers drop dramatically to just under 60,000 due to the volcanic ash cloud situation and subsequent flight cancellations to/from Australia.

On a year-on-year basis, the result is up more than 3,000 visits in the figures from Sep 2014.

Across all international markets, the total number of direct foreign tourist arrivals into Bali during Sep jumped by 37,000 (9%) on the year earlier.

For the year to 30 Sep, int'l visitor numbers are up 7.6%.

**TRAVELLERS** to Moscow now have another must-see attraction - the brand new Crazy Toilet Cafe which opened last week and serves an "array of toilet-inspired dishes in toiletthemed crockery".

According to The Guardian, the somewhat dubious menu at the Arbat Street eatery suggestively includes a "swirled sausage served with piles of mashed potatoes" as well as a creamy brown mushroom soup served in a toilet bowl.

Cocktails, coffee and green tea are appropriately served in miniature urinals.

General manager Inga Yaroslavskaya was quoted as saying "it's not everywhere you can eat good food from a toilet bowl and drink from a urinal at very reasonable prices".

## **Starwood signs SLS**

THE 1,600 room SLS Las Vegas multi-tower hotel will reposition under two Starwood Hotels & Resorts Worldwide brands.

Under a new agreement signed overnight between Starwood and Las Vegas Resort Holdings, SLS will be rebranded under the Tribute portfolio before the end of the year.

The deal with Starwood will also see the 289-room LUX Tower converted to a W Hotel - W Las Vegas - upon its completion of an extensive refurbishment next year, with the upgrade to be managed by Starwood.

### Wellcamp jumbo

QUEENSLAND'S Wellcamp Airport located in Toowoomba will welcome its first international flight later this month.

Cathay Pacific Airways will operate a return Boeing 747-800 Freighter cargo service from Hong Kong to the regional airport on 23 Nov, just a shade over a year since Brisbane West Wellcamp Airport (WTB) began operation.

"We are on the cusp of a massive export opportunity that will give local producers access to markets that feed half of the world's population and this flight is the first step towards achieving this long-term goal," airport developer and owner John Wagner commented.



### **New CEO for Kuoni**

**SWISS** travel conglomerate Kuoni Group has announced the appointment of Zubin Karkaria as its new chief executive officer.

Based in Dubai & currently the ceo of VFS Global, a division of Kuoni Group, Karkaria is the first Indian to head the 109-year old travel services company.

Kuoni Group chairman Heinz Karrer said Karkaria was chosen to accelerate the implementation of a new strategic direction, given his successful leadership of VFS Global into a "global leader".

## **Marriott Alitrip deal**

MARRIOTT International has joined forces with Chinese OTA Alitrip to make it easier for travellers to book hotel rooms online and via smartphones.

Claimed as a "first for a major global hotel chain," the room inventory of the Marriott portfolio will be made available to Alitrip users via a directly operated on-line flagship store.

The service will incorporate Alitrip's "Post Post Pay" system which allows qualified customers to reserve rooms without paying a deposit, and to be automatically charged on check-out.

4,000 hotels across 19 Marriott brands are included in the deal.

## Florida's Brightline

**A NEW** rail service connecting four of Florida's largest cities is slated to be operational by 2017.

Operated by All Aboard Florida, the new line will stretch 235 miles between Miami and Orlando.

The express inter-city line will take around three hours and will offer stops at Fort Lauderdale and West Palm Beach, costing more than US\$3 billion to build.

Dubbed 'Brightline', the service would operate on existing freight lines owned by sister company, Florida East Coast Railway, *USA Today* reported overnight.

Onboard, passengers will have access to free wi-fi and multiple power outlets at every seat, with an option to reserve seating including single seats and tables of up to four.

The locomotives are being built in Sacramento, California by German firm Siemens.

Rival US rail network Amtrak welcomed the announcement.

# **QR** suspending Osaka

**QATAR** Airways looks set to suspend operations on its Doha-Osaka Kansai route, with reservations closed in GDS for travel on/after 01 Apr 2016.

QR currently operates daily A330-200 services to Osaka.

# ihail revises app

**IHAIL** has proposed changes to the way its smartphone taxi booking app will operate, prompting the ACCC to extend the timeframe for making a final decision on ihail's application for authorisation.

The ACCC previously issued a draft decision to deny authorisation to the smartphone app on the grounds it "could impact prices and quality of service" (TD 12 Oct 15).

ihail will now enable in-car payment processing, will remove the priority dispatch mechanism and will change its booking process, allowing users to choose which taxi network services they are booking.

The ACCC has invited comment on the revised ihail arrangements by 08 Dec 2015 and expects to issue a final decision in Feb/Mar



# **AFTA update**

From AFTA's chief executive, Jayson Westbury

TRAVEL plans to Bali have once again been thrust into turmoil by the ash cloud that is hanging over the region. From what is being reported, this may be around for a while longer yet.

No doubt travel agents across the country are doing what they can to accommodate travellers and this

situation has become a well worn track for the airlines dealing with the disruption. There is no easy solution for everyone involved and all we can hope for are some strong winds to get the cloud moving and for Mount Rinigani to settle down soon.

On top of this disruption comes further strike action by our border force officers who have been taking industrial action as a result of a dispute with the Federal Government over pay and conditions.

Yesterday (Mon 09 Nov) I arrived back from the World Travel Agents Association Alliance (WTAAA) board meeting and conference which was held in Spain, to find a seamless, world class passage through immigration and customs. I used my E-passport with no long line, my bag amazingly arrived within a few minutes of me getting to the carousel and I wandered through the "green" nothing to declare exit. In fact, from the door of the plane to the door of the taxi it took me only 11 minutes. Mind you, I have added another Ebola card to my collection which I diligently completed on the plane but with nobody interested or in sight to collect it from me. As I said in a recent TD column, "a waste of time piece of paper". So while I am always good at having a cheap shot at government process, yesterday was a surprise for me as I was expecting a long delay, given the industry action. It would appear that the action taken had little to no impact, but then again perhaps I was just lucky.

AFTA continue to engage with the federal government to improve the arrival and departure experience at all of our international gateways as they look to roll out more e-gates and streamline the experience.

On a final note, I was delighted to be re-elected as Chairman of the WTAAA for another year, the second of my two year term.

#### New Vanuatu aircraft

**QANTAS** has advised that from 12 Nov 2015 through to 31 Jan 2016 services on its codeshare partner Air Vanuatu will be operated by a chartered Transavia B737 aircraft.

Air Vanuatu has chartered the plane from KLM while awaiting the delivery of its new 737-800.

Customers may notice Transavia livery on the aircraft but the customer experience remains unchanged, with Air Vanuatu pilots and cabin crew and a meal service slightly adjusted to accommodate for the reduced galley space.

# Hurtigruten upgrade

**HURTIGRUTEN** Cruises has announced a total makeover of four of its vessels in 2016.

New 'Arctic Interiors' will be installed on the vessels, with the renovation work to be undertaken by the Norwegian Fosen yard - more details in today's issue of Cruise Weekly.

OOH!MEDIA today announced the launch of 'Collect & Connect TV,' a new digital advertising network broadcast at airport baggage carousels in Sydney, Perth, Melbourne and Brisbane.

A total of 44 networked screens capable of full motion animation and audio content will provide the flexibility to run high definition 15-60 second TVC spots in standard, widescreen or modified format.

oOh! spokesperson Robbie Dery said the move will reach more than 70% of flyers across the country - a total of 3.7 million eyeballs per month.
