QANTAS' alliance with American Airlines has been given the green light by New Zealand's transport authority, while US regulators continue to ponder the venture.

NZ Transport Minister Simon Bridges rubber stamped the joint business agreement, saying the Qantas/American Airlines tie-up will likely result in cheaper fares and more choice for passengers travelling between NZ & the USA.

The timing of the authorisation couldn't have been better, with AA confirming yesterday plans to launch new flights from Los Angeles to Auckland, starting Jun.

"This new service will help make Los Angeles and the wider United States more affordable and accessible for Kiwi travellers," Bridges said.

Bridges said AA's AKL service along with United Airlines' plan to commence new San Francisco-Auckland route in Jul 2016 (*TD* 09 Oct), will bring increased competition to the market, all for the benefit of consumers.

"It's great to see airlines responding to the strong demand for travel between New Zealand and the USA," Bridges added.

Over 230,000 US visitors have travelled to New Zealand so far this year, up 11% year-on-year.

Last week, the US Govt sought further details from QF and AA, including the alliance's five-year outlook, departure & traffic data, strategic relationships between Qantas & GDSs, before it would hand down its decision.

SIA tie-up with Lufthansa

SINGAPORE Airlines and

Lufthansa overnight announced a wide-ranging partnership, which will see them cooperate in a joint venture on routes across the globe, including Australia.

Key routes between Singapore and Europe will be operated on a joint venture basis, including SQ's new non-stop services to Dusseldorf (TD Tue).

"The two airline groups also intend to co-operate in key markets in Europe, Southeast Asia and Australia, coordinating schedules to provide customers more convenient connections between route networks, offering joint fare promotions, aligning corporate programs to strengthen the proposition to corporate customers and exploring enhancements to existing frequent flyer program ties," the carriers said in a statement.

The agreement also includes SIA offshoot SilkAir and Lufthansa subsidiaries Swiss and Austrian Airlines.

Lufthansa and Swiss will codeshare on SIA and SilkAir routes serving destinations in

SQ ceo Goh Choon Phong said the jv provides a "solid foundation for numerous commercial cooperation opportunities".

Lufthansa ceo Carsten Spohr, who earlier this year presided over the introduction of the carrier's controversial GDS fee (TD 03 Jun), said the intensified partnership with SIA is a "cornerstone of our Asia strategy".

SIA customers will gain access to additional destinations via the transfer hubs of Frankfurt, Munich and Zurich, with the deal including more than 20 new codeshare routes within Europe covering Austria, Belgium, Germany and Switzerland.



"It's time for the Obama administration to wake up to this blatant violation of its bilateral agreements and request consultations with the UAE & Qatar. American jobs depend upon it," Zuckman said in a statement.



FJ Biz improvements

FIJI Airways is set to reveal the latest phase of its five-year master rebranding plan from Dec. Passengers flying in Business Class on all flights (except to/from the USA) will have their luggage allowance increased from the current 30kg to 40kgs.

Members of Fiji Airways' Tabua Club will be entitled to a further 10kgs, for a total of 50kgs.

On flights to the US, FJ's checked baggage allowance for Business Class customers will ramp up from two pieces to three pieces of luggage, and four pieces if the pax is a Tabua Club member. Starting Jan, Fiji Airways is also ramping up its service offering for top tier travellers.

The new dedicated 'Premium Services Team' will cater for VIPs, CIPs and Tabua Club members travelling in Business Class.

Responsibilities of the team will include Meet & Greet Service at Nadi and Suva Airports for Departures and Arrivals, concierge service, pre-assigned seating and personal assistance for flight connections in Fiji.

The PST will be proactive, contacting VIPs before travel and will have a dedicated phone number & new uniform, "all with the goal of delivering one-on-one individualised service," FJ said.

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
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
