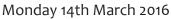
The company, which has been FCM Travel's Netherlands partner for some years, turned over about ten million euro last year.

NT agent guilty of fraud

KATHERINE travel agent Tennille Foley has pleaded guilty to defrauding the NT government of about \$40,000 after her agency was raided by police last month.

Foley, who ran Travelworld Katherine between 2004 and 2014, appeared in court on Fri following charges being laid (TD 08 Mar) with evidence presented of 69 "overstated" invoices submitted to the NT Health Dept under the Territory's pensioner travel concession scheme.

The long-running investigation saw Darwin agent Xana Kamitsis sentenced to almost four years in prison (TD 02 Dec) while the ABC reported NT Health Minister John Elferink said on Fri that Flight Centre may also be involved.

During Fri's hearing prosecutor David Morters said Foley had stated she had been "first introduced to the process of submitting inflated invoices" when she had worked with

another agency, while defence lawyer Peter Maley said his client had worked at Flight Centre between 2000 and 2004.

The court heard Foley had given a formal statement to police and was prepared to testify.

Elferink was quoted by the ABC as saying the government was "continuing to seek redress...if any criminality becomes apparent it will be pursued irrespective of settlement".

A Flight Centre spokesperson told TD "we have committed to repaying any overpayments that were made".

New Caledonia Hot Easter Sale

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ACCC case to High Court

FLIGHT Centre md Graham Turner says he's disappointed the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission is continuing to pursue its long running case against the company, with the ACCC granted special leave for a High Court appeal (*TD* breaking news Fri).

Turner said Flight Centre will "once again vigorously defend our position," with the saga seeing Flight Centre initially fined \$11m but the decision reversed last Jul after a successful appeal.

"Given that it is now some six years after the ACCC first requested information from us, we look forward to this matter finally being resolved in the High Court," Turner said on Fri.

The ACCC launched proceedings in 2012 alleging that between 2005 and 2009 Flight Centre had attempted to induce Malaysia Airlines, Singapore Airlines and Emirates to enter into price fixing arrangements in breach of the Trade Practices Act.

ACCC chairman Rod Sims said he was pleased the case would be considered by the High Court. "This case raises important issues for the application of competition laws in Australia in the future, as online offers are increasingly being made directly to consumers by both agents and their principals," Sims said.

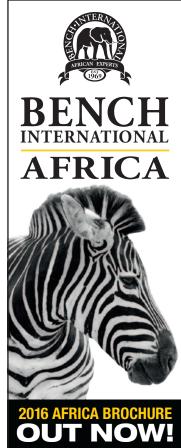
The Full Court of the Federal Court previously unanimously found there was no separate market for distribution and booking services to consumers, and thus Flight Centre and the airlines did not compete with each other.

Turner said "we are not in the business of attempting to make airfares more expensive and we will continue to fight to be able to seek access to all fares to ensure the millions of customers that we serve are not forced to pay more for their flights".

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NZ, VA quest for local biofuel

TRANS-TASMAN airline pals Air New Zealand & Virgin Australia today announced they have instigated a search for a locally produced aviation biofuel.

The pact will see the carriers issue a Request for Information (RFI) to the market with three key principles - to ensure that the alternate green fuel delivers environmental, social and economic benefits.

Air New Zealand chief flight operations & safety officer Captain David Morgan said the RFI is a prime initiative under the Kiwi carrier's carbon management program.

"By working in partnership with our alliance partner Virgin Australia we hope we can stimulate the local market, drive innovation and investment and potentially uncover a sustainable biofuel supply suitable for our respective operations," Captain

Morgan said.

VA's head of sustainability Robert Wood echoed the remark, saying aviation biofuels provide a significant opportunity to stem emissions, at the same time "also building long-term fuel security for the sector".

Wood said: "We are seeing the development of the aviation biofuel industry accelerate internationally but that is not yet the case for our region".

He added the pact with Air NZ "will de-risk investment in the sector, creating high-tech, highskilled jobs in the region".

MEANWHILE, United Airlines began using commercial-scale volumes of sustainable biofuel for regularly scheduled flights from Los Angeles Int'l Airport on Fri.

United has purchased up to 15 million gallons of AltAir Paramount's renewal fuel over a three-year period.

Ankara terror attack

MORE than 30 people were killed in Turkey's capital Ankara overnight when a car ladened with explosives was blown up in the city's transit hub in Kizilay.

The blast comes two days after the US embassy warned its citizens of a "potential terrorist plot to attack Turkish government buildings & housing located in the Bahcelievler areas of Ankara," *The Telegraph* reports.

It's alleged the attack was carried out by Kurdish militant group, Kurdistan Workers' Party, which claimed responsibility for another attack on 17 Feb in Ankara that killed 28 people.

The Australian Department of Foreign Affairs & Trade this morning issue a fresh advisory to Aussies travellers to "avoid the affected area and follow the advice of local authorities".

Smartraveller's official advice for Turkey remains as 'exercise a high degree of caution'.



WE'VE seen some pretty creative flight paths used by airlines in the past, but the owner of a Robin DR-400/180 Regent in Germany has really taken steps to set a new benchmark.

The pilot of the private plane traced the outline of an aircraft over northern Germany on Sat, flying between Hamburg and Heligoland in the North Sea.

According to *FlightRadar24*, the flight took about 1hr and 20mins to complete, which also included a signature (inset).



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NT luxe hotel progress

THE Northern Territory Govt has confirmed receiving interest from eight parties for a mooted new luxury hotel for Darwin's CBD.

Proposed in Aug, the luxury hotel is viewed as a potential catalyst for renewed interest from tourists and the business events market, the NT govt said on Sat.

The Expressions of Interest process lured interest from local and int'l investors with a small number short-listed to proceed to the detailed proposal phase.

"Additional luxury hotel developments would provide a massive boost to the Territory's economy because of the potential to fill a gap in demand for high end business and leisure accommodation," Chief Minister Adam Giles commented.

Giles said a new luxury hotel will build on the success of the current accommodation offering available in the NT capital.

KPMG has been appointed as probity advisors for the project. A preferred proponent is tipped to be announced in Jul.

JetBlue responds to AA/QF sur-reply

JETBLUE Airways has fired back at the "sur-reply" by Qantas and American Airlines (*TD* Thu) to recommendations it made to the US Department of Transportation regarding the term of the flagged antitrust immunity (ATI) sought.

On Fri, JetBlue said QF and AA had failed in their sur-reply to address the merits of their support of a three year cap on the granting of ATI, as proposed by Hawaiian Airlines.

"Rather, American and Qantas use their unauthorised Sur-Reply to suggest that JetBlue is no different from American because it has codeshare and interline partnerships with numerous foreign carriers.

"Surely American, as the world's largest airline and recipient of multiple grants of ATI with partners such as British Airways, Iberia, Finnair & Royal Jordanian, understands the difference between an interline or codeshare agreement and a metal-neutral joint venture exempt from the antitrust laws," JetBlue said.

B6 said there is no correlation between an immunised joint venture & codeshare or interline agreement, urging the DOT not to be "distracted by these illogical ...& wholly irrelevant arguments."
