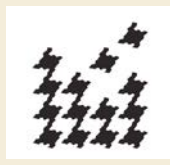
**LOGOS** are the main way that companies distinguish themselves, and some logos are so famous that you don't even need to see the company's name to know who it is.

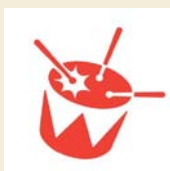
