THIS explosion of colour is a garden which was launched on Valentine's Day in 2013 and remains open to the public today.

The garden covers 72,000m² and is the world's largest natural flower garden, with over 50 million flowers and 250 million plants.

In fact the garden holds three Guinness World records: as the world's largest vertical garden, the biggest flower structure in the world for its A380 installation and the tallest topiary supported sculpture in the world for the 18m-tall Mickey Mouse.
