Malaysian bid for THL LISTED hotel firm Tourism equity stake in Golden Tulip.

LISTED hotel firm Tourism Hotels and Leisure (THL) yesterday received notice of an on-market takeover bid by a firm called SDB Hotels Pty Ltd.

SDB has been formed for the \$6.6m takeover bid and is backed a group of Malaysian investors incl listed property developer and hotel operator SDB Malaysia.

THL claims to be the 18th largest hotel operator in the world, with more than 500 properties in 40 countries under brands including Pacific International, the recently launched Grand Pacific Suites, Plaza Hotels and Golden Tulip.

Golden Tulip also owns 19.9% of THL while THL holds a 30%

Yesterday the board of THL responded to the unsolicited takeover offer by saying it was "considering a number of alternative proposals", and this morning one of

its directors, Alfred Wong, resigned.
Shares in the firm have also been placed in a trading halt at the request of the THL board.

SDB is offering 19c per share for THL stock, which is less than the 20c it was trading at before the bid.

The bidder said if the takeover is successful it would delist THL and replace its board, but maintain the businesses in their current state "under the management of some of the existing executives."

Star out until mid May

CARNIVAL Corporation has reported that last week's fire on Star Princess will see the vessel out of service until 15 May in order to make permanent repairs to cabins damaged during the incident.

The firm said it expected repairs plus cancelled departures during Mar and Apr will cost it about 5c per share or up to US\$42m.

Passengers booked on cruises scheduled for 09, 16, 23 and 30 Apr will receive a full refund of their cruise and non-refundable airfares, plus a future cruise credit of 25% off the fare for these sailings.

Creative makes Africa accessible

THE new Creative Hols Africa program is likely to generate significant consumer interest in a destination which has long been perceived as being out of reach of the ordinary consumer.

Launched under the Creative Experiences banner, the products aim to change the perception of Africa as an expensive destination.

Creative gm Andrew Yell told TD this week that a dedicated team within Creative's reservations area has been trained to help consultants sell the product, with many of the

tours operated by long-established African specialist Thompson Tours, which is also owned by parent firm The Travel Corporation.

He said the Africa brochure has been developed in response to extensive consumer research and includes comprehensive destination information to help travellers plan their holidays, including details supplied through a partnership with Lonely Planet.

"Africa is a destination with wide appeal and has something to offer everyone from honeymooners to families to singles," he said.

The brochure features a wide range of accom ranging from luxury lodges through to camping, climbing tours to the summit of Mount Kilimaniaro, family journeys and resort packages in Mozambique and Mauritius.

Africa adds to the other new Creative Experiences brochures for China, Vietnam Cambodia and Laos, plus India Sri Lanka and Maldives, and Yell said other destinations are also being considered for the Experiences range, probably to launch in 2008.

Qantas doubles excess baggage charges

EFFECTIVE 08 Apr Qantas will increase its charges for additional domestic baggage to \$22 per piece, up from the current \$11 impost.

International excess baggage charges will also increase by about 20%, with the new rates ranging from \$12 per kg for flights under 1000km right through to \$48 per kg for flights longer than 7000km.

6500 staff to go at MH

MALAYSIA Airlines has confirmed details of a major restructure which will see it lay off 6500 of its staff and hand over 96 routes to budget carrier AirAsia.

The Malaysian govt will also cease any subsidies from 01 Aug, with "the profit-and-loss account for domestic routes to be borne by Malaysia Airlines, not by the government."

MH will retain 19 popular tourist domestic routes incl destinations such as Penang, Kota Kinabalu, Kuching and Langkawi.

Officials said it's expected many of the staff made redundant will be absorbed by AirAsia.


More passport checks

IN an effort to stop the misuse of lost or stolen passports, New Zealand has entered into an information-sharing agreement with the US and Australia.

The regional movement alert list programme ensures that when someone tries to travel with a lost or stolen passport between the countries they will be detected and border agencies alerted.

Initial checks include verifying serial numbers and expiry dates of passports, but more info sharing between the countries will take place if stolen or lost passports are identified.

Warning for Reunion Is

THE outbreak of Chikungunya, a mosquito-borne virus, continues to affect the French Island of Reunion in the Indian Ocean, with DFAT today updating its travel warning there.

The report said there has been a sizable number of cases of the disease reported in Reunion as well as in Seychelles and Mauritius, with thousands infected and some deaths.

Symptoms of the virus, transmitted by the bite of an infected mosquito, include fever, severe rash and joint pains and there is currently no vaccine or treatment for the disease.

The warning suggests travellers use strategies normally applied to malaria affected areas.

Strike cancels flights

A STRIKE in France caused major disruptions to transportation yesterday with cancelled flights, trains and buses.

Hundreds of thousands of students and workers have being holding demonstrations for the past three weeks to protest against pending employment laws that are set to remove job protections from young people.

Almost a third of Paris flights were cancelled or delayed because of striking air traffic controllers.

Boeing's stretch version

BOEING said it will proceed with an expanded version of its 787 Dreamliner jet, bowing to pressure from airlines, including Emirates, who has long been an advocate of the larger plane.

The new jet will seat around 300 passengers and will begin flying in late 2012.

Boeing had been reluctant to build a larger version of the 787 because of concerns it would deter sales of its 777-200ER jet.
