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



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New Micronesian carrier

AUSTRALIAN travel company Aerius Travel has today launched a new Palau-based airline which will operate thrice weekly flights from Brisbane to Micronesia.

Dubbed PacificFlier, the carrier commences operation on 07 Jan 2010 using an Airbus A310 aircraft which will market both passenger and cargo services to Guam and Palau from Australia, the Philippines and Japan.



PacificFlier is the first Palaubased carrier to operate flights to Australia since the 2004 demise of Palau Micronesia Air, which flew for just a month between Darwin and Palau (TD 14 Oct 04).

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DJ deal delay

VIRGIN Blue has confirmed that it's not expecting a US ruling on the proposed joint venture between V Australia and Delta Air Lines until the middle of 2010.

The deal has reportedly become caught up in the wider issue of airline alliances in the USA, with authorities also currently considering a proposal for transatlantic cooperation between British Airways and American Airlines.

The DL-VA joint venture has already received provisional approval from the ACCC.

Qantas tops satisfaction

TIGER Airways and Jetstar significantly lag Virgin Blue and Qantas in terms of customer satisfaction, according to a Roy Morgan poll released yesterday.

The figures showed that between Aug and Oct 2009, 81.8% of Australians who took a QF domestic flight over the last year were 'very' or 'fairly' satisfied.

That was just slightly ahead of Qantaslink at 79.6%, which in turn just pipped Virgin Blue at 78.4%.

By contrast Jetstar showed a satisfaction level of 67.8% - while the figures for Tiger Airways appeared to bear out the

Car cartel OK-ACCC

THE Australian Competition and Consumer Commission has agreed to allow a group of car rental companies to collectively negotiate with Mackay Airport.

Hertz, Thrifty, Avis, Budget and Europear all currently offer car rental services at the airport, and lodged an application with the ACCC to be allowed to present a united front in talks with officials.

ACCC Chairman Graeme Samuel said a key feature of the pact is that the proposed arrangements are voluntary, with the airport free to choose whether to participate in the collective negotiations or continue to deal with each rental firm individually.

EUROPCAR Australia is seeking to expand in suburban Sydney, soliciting expressions of interest for a new franchisee in the area.

The company says it's a business opportunity for a "highly qualified, motivated individual seeking the rewards and support of an established brand name."

Europear said applicants should have a "strong commitment to increasing market share in the car rental sector and unparalleled service to the Europear customer."

Roy Morgan Research's Jane lannello said: "Although Jetstar was launched by Qantas as a low cost carrier to compete with Virgin Blue, the airline has not been able to match Virgin Blue's relatively high level of customer satisfaction.

"It remains to be seen whether public dissatisfaction with the Jetstar service will affect their growth as a domestic carrier."

Disney rehash site

DISNEY has just revamped its travel agents website, bringing together its Disney Destinations, Disney Cruise Line and Adventures by Disney tour programs for the first time.

Disney Destinations Int'l sales and marketing director Sean Harrigan told *TD* yesterday that the expanded portal now provides agents with all the latest Disney information at their fingertips.

"With the recently announced Disney Cruise Line itineraries for Alaska and Mexican Riveria...and the tour offerings around the world for Adventures by Disney there are now more opportunities for your clients to experience the magic of Disney than ever before," Harrigan said.

He said that the Disney Learning Collection is all new, replacing the previous Disney Stars program.

The DLC contains stand-alone courses on Disneyland Resort, Walt Disney World Resort, Disney Cruise Line and Adventures by Disney, while modules on Disneyland Paris and Hong Kong Disneyland are in the pipe-line.

The new site will require previously registered agents to reregister, with those who sign up before Fri 18 Dec offered the chance to win a Disney DVD pack.

Window Seat

THE ancient Italian city of Pompeii has been added to the Google Street View application, allowing virtual tourists to stroll the city's ruined streets in 3-D via the internet.

The site, which was destroyed by the volcanic eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79AD, is one of the world's top tourist attractions.

A spokesman for Italy's culture ministry claimed that: "Giving people a chance to take a virtual stroll through Pompeii will give an extraordinary boost to Italian tourism."

THERE'S outrage in the UK this week over a decision to close down a military hotline which took reports of UFOs.

The service and an associated email address are now offline, with an army spokesman saying more than 50 years of UFO sightings have not revealed any evidence of alien visitors.

The army said the money which supported the UFO service could be better used funding operations in Afghanistan.

POPULAR vehicle enthusiast TV show *Top Gear* claims to be attempting to "solve the problem of airport delays" in its latest episode, in which the presenters conduct a race between "some assorted runway support vehicles".

Luggage carts, a fuel tanker, a tarmac bus, mobile aircraft stairs, a fire engine, a catering truck and even an aircraft tug compete in the groundbreaking event at an unnamed UK airport.

Lilianfels selling

ORIENT-EXPRESS Hotels Ltd has announced it has entered into a sale and purchase agreement to sell Lilianfels Blue Mountains in Katoomba, NSW to an undisclosed buyer for \$21m.

President and ceo of the hotel group Paul White said, "This is a further execution of our ongoing strategy to dispose on non-core businesses."

"We are delighted that this transaction, which represents 17 times the hotel's 2009 EBITDA and 23 times its 2008 EBITDA, once again underlines the value of properties in the Orient-Express portfolio," said White.

Orient-Express Hotels, which also owns the Observatory Hotel in Sydney, says it will continue to operate the hotel until the transaction closes, which is expected to be late Jan 2010.

Airlines flock to BNE

CHINA Eastern Airlines (MU) and Garuda Indonesia both have their eyes locked on Brisbane Int'l Airport, with both carrier's planning to operate flights to the Queensland capital next year.

MU has loaded limited direct flights between Shanghai-Brisbane from mid-Feb into agent GDSs, while *TD* understands GA are planning to reinstate Brisbane-Bali from Mar with a four times weekly service using an Airbus A330-300.

MEANWHILE, China Southern Airlines has announced its added two weekly flights between Sydney-Guangzhou to become a daily operation, effective immediately until 20 Feb 2010.

CZ is also introducing three nonstop services between Melbourne-Guangzhou, replacing three flights via Sydney.

Regional manager Australia James Liu said the increase is not only fueled by Christmas holiday traffic but as a result fo CZ's connections to Asia, Europe, the Middle East and Africa.

QantasLink boost

AIR services to Mildura in the Victorian Sunraysia region as well as Devonport and Launceston in Tasmania will receive a boost from 01 Feb when QantasLink takes delivery of a new Q400 aircraft.

The 74-seat plane will be based in Melbourne and bolster capacity to Mildura by 9% per week, or 224 seats, on 13 flights between the city pairs.

It will also be used to service the Melbourne-Devonport route (1 extra return flight per week) and the Melbourne-Launceston route (3 weekly return services).

oneworld e-signature initiative

THE oneworld airline alliance is claiming another first by becoming the first global airline grouping to enable corporate customers to complete contracts electronically.

The first ever oneworld deal to be sealed in this way was negotiated in Australia, with international mining group Rio Tinto through its procurement head office in Brisbane.

The alliance said that up until now agreements between oneworld and multinational corporate clients were completed using paper and pen, by representatives of the customer and all the alliance member airlines participating in the deal.

This meant contracts had to crisscross the globe with the process usually taking weeks and incurring significant postal costs.

Under the new arrangement, through electronic signature company DocuSign, the whole process can be handled securely via the internet, meaning contracts can be easily authorised much faster.

The Rio Tinto deal required signatures from the company's offices in Brisbane and Paris as well as airline executives from oneworld member carriers in North and South America, Europe, the Middle East, Asia and Australia.

FORMER Qantas ceo Geoff Dixon is being used by PM Kevin Rudd to assist with ramping up support amongst Australian states for the country's bid for either the 2018 or 2022 World Cup, according to the *Sun Herald*.

West Coast tax rise

AIRPORTS across California are planning to raise their Passenger Facility Charge by nearly 70% to cover increasing capital costs.

The move follows the establishment of the California Airports Council (CAC) in the state which is comprised of executive directors and CEO's of 30 commercial airports including Los Angeles and San Francisco Int'l Airports.

CAC propose to lift the PFC tax, which goes towards airport terminal enhancements, gate expansions, public transport systems and more, from its current US\$4.50 charge to US\$7.50 per person.


