TRAVEL2 has moved to immediately match Creative Holidays' 15% commission offer (TD yesterday), with Travel 2 this morning announcing it would pay 15% commission at source for all UK/Europe bookings made via calypsonet until 28 Feb 2010.

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Carnival marketing push

CARNIVAL Australia today urged travel agents to prepare for "another wave of cruise bookings" as it launches a major marketing campaign.

Dubbed 'Australia's Biggest Cruise Sale', the promotion will see P&O Cruises advertised in conjunction with the Melbourne Open tennis as well as on press, TV and radio across the country.

P&O will have local capacity of almost 8000 passengers with the arrival of *Pacific Pearl* later this year, and is keen to secure early bookings for the 2010/11 season.

Carnival Australia vice president Jenny Lourey said the campaign reflected a trend towards early bookings for shorter cruises over the last two years.

"We've seen a significant increase in the number of cruise passengers booking their holidays 9-12 months in advance to secure

the best deal, so we've decided to put some great fares in the market for late 2010 and 2011," Lourey said.

"We think the campaign will help drive customers through travel agents' doors," she added.

The deals, on sale until 31 Mar, start at \$799pp quad share for a 7 night *Pacific Sun* South Pacific cruise ex Brisbane.

There's also a \$1599ppts lead-in on a 10 night *Pacific Jewel* cruise ex Sydney, an 8 night *Pacific Pearl* trip ex Sydney to Tasmania and Melbourne priced from \$939pp quad share, and a 10-night *Pacific Sun* departure from Newcastle to the South Pacific from \$999pp quad share.

CARNIVAL'S *Dawn Princess* has been hit by a gastric bug, with more than 240 passengers affected on a 13-night New Zealand cruise which ended on Monday in Melbourne.

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Qantas offers JAL help

QANTAS executive manager Rob Gurney has offered to share the secrets of the QF "two-brand" model to Japan Airlines, as part of a *oneworld* push to keep JAL within the alliance.

Speaking at a Tokyo press conference (*TD* yesterday), Gurney said a Jetstar-style Japanese carrier could see JAL's "competitive position improved in both the leisure and business segments."

"It will enable it to differentiate its product offering with appropriate cost structures for different markets," he said.

During the media event Gurney was joined by executives from fellow *oneworld* members

American Airlines, British Airways and Cathay Pacific, who said they had offered commitments and benefits worth US\$2 billion over three years to help JAL - including more coordination of operations on routes to the UK, USA and Australia.

However no additional funds were announced yesterday, and there's increasing expectation that JAL will opt for a rescue package offered by Delta Airlines and other carriers which could see it end up part of the rival SkyTeam alliance.

Japanese reports suggest that JAL could be placed into a form of bankruptcy protection as early as next week, but the carrier has emphasised that operations will continue normally in that event.

Tiger accelerates aircraft deliveries

TIGER Airways has confirmed a new financing deal which will allow for the early delivery of five Airbus A320 aircraft.

The planes were originally scheduled for deployment in 2016, but will now be delivered later this year and early in 2011.

CEO Tony Davis said the move was "in view of the opportunities for us to grow our business in both Asia and Australia".

2009 was clearly a tough year in travel - as evidenced by the annual report from industry lobby group The Tourism and Transport Forum.

One of the line items in the TTF balance sheet shows "Wine on hand" valued at \$18,509 as at 30 Jun last year.

The figure for the previous corresponding year was \$25,808, meaning that the TTF went through \$7,299 worth of its wine stocks in 2008/09 - probably to ease the stress of the global financial crisis.

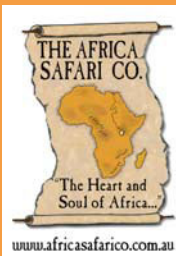
WHO said New York cab drivers aren't helpful?

She made the remark at the official draw ceremony of the Medibank International Sydney tennis tournament, which this year is expecting to attract about 100,000 visitors.

In 2009, the tennis title lured close to 900,000 spectators

McKay said the significant TV coverage of the event would be beamed to over 250 million people, here and to key overseas markets, showcasing the city.

Referring to the NSW capital, she said, "we've got the tennis in January, the Autumn Racing Carnival in March, FIFA fan fest in June and July, the Bledisloe Cup in September and the Australian Open Golf in December.

"With all of these great sporting events throughout the year, Vivacity festival in January, Vivid Festival in June and Crave festival in Oct, NSW is the Major events capital of Australia," McKay said.

CO lifts bag charge

CONTINENTAL Airlines has responded quickly to match Delta Air Lines' decision to raise checked luggage fees on domestic US services (*TD* yesterday).

CO is now charging economy class passengers US\$25 their first checked bag and US\$35 for a second checked bag, for pax who booked flights after 09 Jan.

Passengers who prepay for their luggage via Continental's website will save between US\$2 or US\$3.

It's predicted American Airlines will match the increased levy.

Malaria warning

TRAVELVAX Australia is advising Aussies travelling to Kruger NP in South Africa to ensure that they take anti-malarial medication with them over coming months.

The call comes after more than 1,000 cases of the illness were reported in the Limpopo province since the rainy season began.

A spokesman for the provincial department of health, Selby Makgatho said last week, "We do not have an outbreak now but the situation is expected to take a turn for the worse."

Orient Italy growth

ORIENT-Express Hotels Ltd has penned a deal to purchase two new properties in Taormina, Sicily.

The Grand Hotel Timeo and Villa Sant'Andrea will come under the Orient-Express brand from later this month after the firm signed a binding deal worth €81m (\$AU127m) with The Framon Group.

The sister Sicilian hotels will undergo a major refurbishment program (€11m) over the next 3 winter closures.

The acquisition brings the Orient group's total number of Italian properties to eight.

Last month, Orient-Express off-loaded one of its few Australian assests, Lilianfels Blue Mountains, for \$21m (TD 08 Dec) and also bought the Hotel Rio Sagrado in the Sacred Valley of the Incas in Peru for US\$7m (TD 30 Dec).

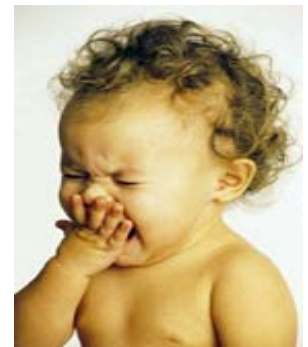
