THE union representing British Airways long-haul cabin crew says its members will vote next week on another wave of strike action. The ballot will take place

between 29 Jun and 27 Jul, and if it votes for a strike the earliest a walkout could take place is 04 Aug under UK industrial relations laws.

BA said it would strengthen its contingency plans, with the aim of operating 100% of its longhaul schedule and a "substantial proportion" of its shorthaul schedule from Heathrow if the industrial action goes ahead.

The carrier has also announced it's seeking to employ a further 1250 cabin crew under a "new fleet" strategy which will see new London Heathrow-based staff employed under similar (lowerpaid) conditions to those at BA's Gatwick Airport base.

SYD flags increase

SYDNEY Airport today said it would seek ACCC approval to increase its regional aeronautical fees for the first time since 2001.

The security charge is set to move from 87c to 90c per pax, while the T2 passenger facilitation charge will rise 13c to \$4.63 per passenger and runway charges will rise by 10c to \$3.54 per tonne.

The airport said the increases, amounting to about 22c per passenger, would not apply to QantasLink, Jetstar or Virgin Blue because these airlines had already successfully negotiated commercial agreements.
