GLENDA Tuaine, acting ceo of Cook Islands Tourism, has resigned from her position, along with the organisation's Auckland-based NZ representative Chris Ingram.

The moves were revealed today in Rarotonga at the first ever Cook Islands Travel Mart.

The departures also follow the return to Australia earlier this month of the previous CI Tourism ceo John Dean after he resigned in Jan after less than 2 years.

A Cook Islands Tourism board meeting is set for tomorrow but members are being tight-lipped about what will happen.

Tuaine told TD she will finish up at the end of Apr and is happy about her achievements over the last five years in helping to reposition the destination.

SYD runway works

SYDNEY Airport has completed its \$100m runway safety area zone which saw the construction of an 8,100 square metre concrete land bridge built at the western end of the East-West runway.

The safety area was built to aid aircraft in the event of an overrun when landing, and to assist with aircraft deceleration.

Work on the project began in Apr 2008 (TD 20 Mar 08) and saw the disruption of flight corridors over Sydney by increasing traffic on the north-south approaches.

Sydney Airport says "normal operations" will return on 01 Apr.

ACCC ticks airline group

THE competition watchdog has issued a draft determination which proposes to grant authorisation for collective negotiations by airlines via the Board of Airline Representatives of Australia (BARA).

The authorisation would allow

BA keeps flying

BRITISH Airways has confirmed that its London to Sydney flights will continue to operate as planned during the next wave of the carrier's cabin crew strike scheduled for 27-30 Mar.

BA said it would operate about 70% of its long-haul flights ex Heathrow, with regional mgr Nicole Backo saying the continuation of operations shows the airline's "ongoing commitment to the Australian market."

MEANWHILE BA has also said that cabin crew who participated in last weekend's 3-day walkout will permanently lose their travel privileges with the carrier.

A spokesperson told Britain's Sky News that the staff travel program is "a non-contractual perk that the company can withdraw at its discretion".

BARA to continue its current role of representing carriers in talks with major airports, the Bureau of Meteorology and Airservices Australia, with ACCC chairman Graeme Samuel saying the move was "likely to continue to deliver benefits, including in the form of transaction cost savings for both the providers of essential airport services and the airlines."

Given the relative bargaining position of the airports, Samuel said the collective arrangement would be "more likely to provide the airlines with an enhanced level of input," with feedback on the ruling due by 07 Apr.

Jetstar-JAL c'share

JAPAN Airlines has announced an expansion of its codeshare agreement with Jetstar to cover the new JQ flights between Osaka Kansai and Cairns.

The four times weekly services debut on 01 Apr and will operate with flight numbers JL5079 and JL5070 as well as JQ15/16.

Fares issued by JAL for the Jetstar-operated flights will be for economy class only but will be inclusive of meals and soft drinks.

DON'T panic - rail travel in

France is very safe. But you wouldn't have thought so if you'd looked at the website of train operator SNCF on Tue,

which carried an announcement

of one of the worst rail disasters in history.

Part of an emergency drill accidentally saw the fake press release put onto the main public SNCF site, saying that 102 people had been killed and 380 injured due to an explosion on a TGV service in Burgundy.

The message was online for about 45 minutes but luckily didn't lead to widespread panic.

A spokesperson apologised, saying that "a dozen times a year we test out scenarios like this...which are completely made up.

"We go as far as possible in our simulations, and this time we went a little too far," he said.

IT didn't take long for the new full body scanning systems to create controversy.

A male security worker at London Heathrow Airport is facing disciplinary action over a claim that he "ogled" a female colleague who mistakenly strayed into one of the devices, which can see through clothing to produce a body image.

The 25-year-old allegedly "made lewd comments" after his coworker stepped into the scanner, with the woman telling the London Sun tabloid that she had been traumatised by what had happened.

Police said a "first instance harassment warning" had been issued to the staffer, with the incident providing ammunition for opponents of the systems who say they breach individuals' right to privacy.

There's an annual payment fee of \$25 to display a vehicle but that's small change considering the firm says car owners can earn as much as \$24,000 a year.




