CTC gsa by 31 Dec

THE Canadian Tourism Commission has confirmed that it expects to have its new Australian gsa arrangements in place by the end of next month.

CTC spokesman Rupert Peters told *TD* overnight that at this stage there was no "precise timeline" for the appointment, although the initial request for tender had a 31 Aug deadline for submissions by prospective gsas.

The move to close the Australian office and replace it with a gsa arrangement was revealed by *Travel Daily* earlier this year (*TD* 19 Jul) as part of a shake-up of CTC's global strategy.

Peters said that until the gsa is appointed it's "business as usual."

"Going forward we are gearing up for increased marketing investment in Australia," he said.

"The Australian market to Canada has grown 13% YTD from January to August, and we are committed to maintaining growth into 2011, working in partnership with the Australian and Canadian travel industry," he said.

Vietnam update

THE Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade has reissued its travel advice for Vietnam, with new information about tourists becoming victims of "taxi scams".

Travellers arriving on flights are advised to use airport taxis or prearranged hotel transfers.

The update also advises of severe rainstorms in central regions of the country.

Indigenous domestic push

TOURISM Australia has released a new guide on how to sell Indigenous experiences to the domestic market, after research it commissioned to "better understand what Australians expect of Indigenous tourism experiences".

The 2009 study found that Indigenous tourism was behind other domestic holiday options such as beach holidays and city breaks "due to its limited ability to satisfy the key domestic holiday needs of refreshment and indulgence".

And while most Aussies don't dislike Indigenous experiences, they are very familiar with stereotypical activities such as boomerang throwing and the corroboree "and thus these experiences are often perceived to be mostly inauthentic, clichéd and designed for the international tourist market".

The new guide says that despite

this there is domestic demand for Indigenous offerings if Australians can be "convinced of the quality of the experience".

Operators are advised to target older Australians and those with older children because they are more interested in learning.

Tourism Research Australia also concluded that there was an opportunity for operators to leverage off the business events market to create an "interest and desire to engage in an Indigenous tourism experience in future personal travels".

Other factors to consider include ensuring that images communicate the "safety, comfort, consistency and professionalism of product", with many domestic tourists feeling that Indigenous activities are "remote, can be uncomfortable and sometimes dangerous".

LAN beefs up RIO

LAN Airlines has added capacity to Rio de Janeiro from Santiago, Chile, with a seasonal third daily service to operate from 01 Jan to 01 May 2011.

TG leases 8 777s

THAI Airways International has signed a long term lease on eight Boeing 777-300ER aircraft, with delivery of the aircraft due from Aug 2012 to Oct 2013.

Hotels want to bargain together

THE Australian Hotels Association has applied to the ACCC for an authorisation which would allow it to collectively bargain with various suppliers on behalf of its members.

The AHA has divisions in each state and already has an existing authorisation for collective negotiation, which the group want to have revoked in favour of a new agreement which would give members "more input and cost effectiveness into the competitive

process between buyers and suppliers".

The move seeks to help smaller operators to counter the power of supermarkets when negotiating with suppliers such as liquor, insurance, catering supplies, music, accommodation, security and IT services.

About 142 suppliers are targeted under the proposed arrangements, with the AHA saying that "in all cases the public benefits flow".

The current AHA authorisation expires on 30 Apr 2011.

MEANWHILE the newly appointed chairman of the Vic division of the AHA, Peter Crinis, has applauded the state govt's plan to expand the Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Centre.

The \$242m plan will see a new 12,000 square metre "versatile exhibition space" which is expected to be finished in 2014

"By investing in world class infrastructure... the government is ensuring continued significant growth of jobs in the hotel sector," Crinis said.

CBR upgr opening

CANBERRA Airport will open its new Southern Concourse Terminal Extension on 14 Nov.

The terminal will house check-in and baggage collection for all Qantas, Virgin Blue, Brindabella Airlines and Tiger Airways flights.

A NEW lodge-based 4-day Greater Kruger Wildlife Safari at Kapama Private Game Reserve has been added to the just released 2011/12 Kumuka Africa & Middle East brochure.

ETOA anti Rome tax

THE head of the European Tour Operators Association has written to Rome authorities, seeking to delay a new hotel tax which is slated to be introduced from 01 Jan next year.

Executive director Tom Jenkins said the planned Rome visitor tax is an "involuntary imposition of a fee" as it does not specify when it will be imposed from, and means patrons "cannot cancel without forfeiting their prepayment, and they cannot stay without paying this new charge."

Jenkins said clients were "trapped" by the levy, and that ETOA members who have already paid in advance for their client's hotel stays would be unable to foot the bill, meaning patrons would have to pay the tax upon departure.

"Such taxes are always a bad move... It takes a very particular form of city to place a price on its attractiveness," he said.

The ETOA is recommending that Rome officials allow an 18 month grace period before the tax is implemented.

Self tagging bags

AMERICAN Airlines and Air Canada are considering trialling a new self tagging luggage system for the first time in the US, with Boston Logan Airport earmarked as the first airport.

The trial will give pax the ability to print bag tags from self service kiosks and place them directly onto their own luggage, according to the *USA Today*.

The move aims to speed up the check-in process and free up the carrier's check-in crew.
