FIND CRUISES

THE Austrian National Tourist Office has reported a 20.5% yearon-year increase in Australian visitors during the peak 'summer period' (May-Sep), ANTO director for Australia/NZ, Astrid Mulholland-Licht has revealed.

Speaking at the inaugural 'Austria. Destination Summit' this week in Vienna (p3), Mulholland-Licht said the Australian sector was one of the country's key markets to show positive growth, emerging after the financial crisis.

The year-to-date figure (Jan-Sep) was also very healthy, with numbers spiking by nearly 13% on the same time last year.

Mulholland-Licht said early indicators for the quiet months and winter season were promising as well, and she is predicting that the 12 month calendar year figure will be up around 15%-16% on that of 2009.

ANTO chief executive, Petra Stolba, told attendees at the summit that Australia, while only a very small slice of Austria's inbound business, is one of the country's most important longhaul markets.

Over 250,000 Aussies visited Austria in 2009, 19% of whom were travelling on Europe river cruises that passed through the country.

Vienna, one of the most visited locations by Aussies, has also seen growth from the local market.

Norbert Kettner, md of the Vienna Tourist Board, told TD overnight that 2010 has been the second best year for revenue raised for the city, based on room nights sold to Ausrtalians.

Kettner said that "city tourism figures are one of the first indicators" that reflect an overall shift in market habits, and he said he expects visitor numbers, and stay durations, to continue to surge above and beyond the previous all time peak levels, pre the financial crisis.

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QUEENSLAND Police have issued an official warning about a "highly sophisticated" airline ticketing scam, similar to the recent WA alert about cheaperflights.com.au (TD 01 Nov) which was using the BestFlights ABN.

The QId alert relates to several other sites including flisave.com and cheapflightsonly.net - all of which offer discounted flights without pre-payment.

In the most recent case travellers were asked to make payment via an online facility to a bank account in South Africa after tickets arrived, but other instances involved payments to Australian bank accounts "believed to be operated by mules," the Old police statement said.

The tickets delivered are legitimate airline tickets, but have been purchased using stolen credit cards.

"The customer can even ring the airline and confirm their seats - but once the airline realises the credit card used to buy the ticket is stolen, the ticket is cancelled," said Detective Superintendent Brian Hay of the Qld Police Fraud and Corporate Crime Group.

"This is a warning to potential travellers to be aware that sites like these are operating out there right now," he said.

"Potential customers should do as much homework as they can to verify any website they purchase from is legitimate - stick to reputable websites," he added.

The flisave.com website is still operating today, advertising flights from Jetstar, Virgin Blue, Qantas, Emirates and many other carriers at discounts of up to 65%.

New QF, JQ routes

QANTAS will operate non-stop services between Melbourne and Darwin from 17 May next year, with the new QF route complementing Jetstar's eleven weekly services on the route.

Initially the QF 737 Cityflier flight will operate three times per week, increasing to four per week effective 28 Jun 2011.

MEANWHILE Jetstar yesterday announced the launch of "innovative" direct Hobart to Gold Coast flights, with daily operations from 22 Dec.

JQ will be the only carrier to operate on the route, establishing a direct link to Tasmania from its Gold Coast hub which connects through to Japan and NZ.

Jetstar also announced it would boost frequencies between Melbourne and Hobart to six times per day over the summer holiday period (22 Dec-31 Jan).

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Australia ON SALE



A NEW market in second-hand jets has emerged, with South American drugs gangs reportedly purchasing old planes to smuggle cocaine across the Atlantic.

US authorities have issued a warning about the practice, which is proliferating because of repeated interceptions of shipments by boat, says AP.

Last year a burned-out Boeing 727 was found in the desert in the north African nation of Mali, which had apparently been flown in from Venezuela, fully laden with drugs destined for the European market, before being torched by the criminals.

HUMAN headline Sir Richard Branson is set to complete a challenge he laid down to former Qantas ceo Geoff Dixon.

After losing a bet with AirAsia founder Tony Fernandes over which of their Formula One racing teams would do better this season, Branson will don an AirAsia uniform and work as a "stewardess" on an upcoming AirAsia X flight between Kuala Lumpur and London Stansted.

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IASC OK's Jetstar/JAL c'share

JETSTAR will expand its codeshare pact with Japan Airlines to cover flights between Cairns and Osaka as well as the Gold Coast and Tokyo, after a Qantas application for renewal of the agreement was approved by the International Air Services Commission yesterday.

The ruling, which covers the "continuation and expansion" of the deal, is valid until the end of 2012 - but as per a QF request will no longer involve the Sydney-Gold Coast sector.

In its application Qantas said the code share arrangements would enable Jetstar to continue having access to Japan Airline's distribution capability including its wholesale and retail presence in the Japanese market.

The IASC says that while there has been some return to growth over the last year, the route which was once overwhelmingly dominated by Japanese travellers now has a substantial proportion of Australian residents flying.

After major declines in traffic throughout the end of 2008 and 2009, this has now stabilised with strong growth evident in Jun, Jul and Aug 2010 as the Japanese economy recovers, but Jetstar's yields "remain subdued".

Carnival Corporation announced that voyages would be cancelled through until the 09 Jan departure to fix damage caused by an engine room fire, which was sparked by a leak from one of the vessel's six diesel generators.

The ship, which launched just two years ago, is currently docked in San Diego where it was towed by tugboats after crew were unable to restore power, leaving passengers without lights, hot food, refrigeration and even working toilets for some time.

Passengers on the cancelled cruises will receive a full refund of their fare plus air costs, as well as a 25% future cruise discount.

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
