



BARA slams govt airport inaction

THE current aeronautical price monitoring regime is ineffective because the findings of the ACCC and concerns raised by airlines "are not being acted upon by the Australian Government," according to a submission to the Productivity Commission released today by the Board of Airline Representatives.

BARA executive director Warren Bennett says airlines are particularly concerned about the urgent need for corrective action against Sydney Airport.

The current govt strategy of

commissioning high level reviews is "clearly ineffectual," he said, with BARA recommending that the roles of the ACCC, the Productivity Commission and the govt be more clearly defined.

The board suggested that a small independent body could be established to make formal recommendations about the need for stricter regulation, with the current ACCC price monitoring arrangements not providing enough incentive for airports to stop abusing their market power




