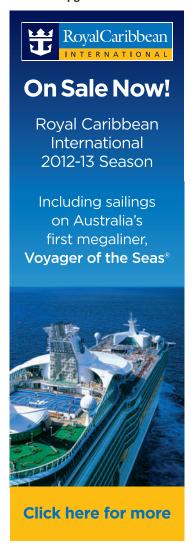

CASA files Tiger case

THE Civil Aviation Safety Authority yesterday formally lodged its application with the Federal Court seeking an order that Tiger Airways Australia not fly until 01 Aug 2011.

CASA said the suspension of Tiger's operating certificate continues in the meantime, with the Court listing Fri 22 Jul for a directions hearing.

MEANWHILE the Australian Transport Safety Bureau has also released its preliminary report into the "operational noncompliance" of a Tiger flight as it landed at Melbourne Airport on 07 Jun - one of the incidents which led to the grounding.

During the approach to the runway the flight was cleared to descend to 2500 feet, but shortly afterwards the plane's track was seen via air traffic control radar to descend to 2000 feet.

"ATC notified the flight crew, who climbed the aircraft to 2500 ft, continued the approach and landed," the report says.

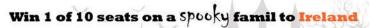
The investigation into the A320 incident is continuing.

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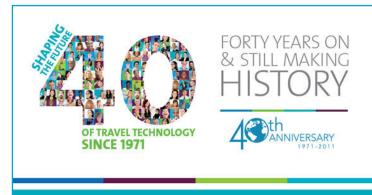

The organisation has suggested higher prices for terminal navigation as well as aviation rescue and fire fighting services over the next five years - with the charges levied on airlines and flowing through to passengers.

"The ACCC's preliminary view is that the proposed prices are higher than required to cover costs and provide a reasonable return," said the ACCC.

ACCC chairman Graeme Samuel said it appeared that Airservices

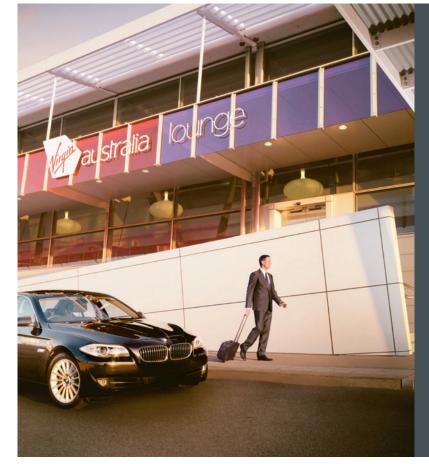
