\$8.5m regional tourism lift

"These grants will help better position those businesses and organisations who are looking to expand, modify or diversify their product or service to be even more appealing for city dwellers and int'l visitors," Ferguson said.

Projects are spread nationally & vary from feasibility studies for possible new attractions, through to covering construction costs.

TQUAL grants vary in value from \$16,500 up to the maximum amount of \$110,000.

Virgin/Air NZ fares aligned

AIR New Zealand and Virgin Australia yesterday officially launched their trans-Tasman pact, with a combined network and schedule on flights between Australia and New Zealand.

The launch means that members of each carrier's loyalty program can also earn and redeem points on applicable Tasman fares on either airline.

It's only the first stage of the combined network, with the full implementation effective 01 Nov.

The frequent flyer partnership covers both trans-Tasman routes and Virgin Australia and Air NZ domestic destinations in both Australia and NZ, but does not include Pacific Island flights.

Earning rates vary depending on the type of fare, with the cheapest discount economy classes earning 0.25 points per mile flown, with this increasing depending on the fare class to one point per mile for full economy fares.

Premium Economy earns 1.5 points per mile, while Business class fares earn 2 Velocity points per mile flown, and on all fares bonuses are available for Silver

(20%) and Gold (40%) members.

Effective immediately eligible pax can also receive reciprocal entry to the other carrier's lounges.

Yesterday's commencement of the pact coincided with an Air NZ board meeting in Brisbane.

HTO lauds Hawaiian Air daily move

THE head of Hawaii Tourism Oceania says the organisation is "delighted" with the confirmation that Hawaiian Airlines would restart daily services between Honolulu and Sydney this year.

Yesterday afternoon the carrier announced it would begin a daily year-round service from 14 Dec, using Boeing 767-300ER aircraft due to "increasing demand."

"Travel demand to Hawaii from Australia over the past 18 months has been tracking strongly and we are having a cracker of a year," HTO Country Manager Helen Williams told TD yesterday. Williams said 2010 saw an

additional 26% growth in visitors and for the period Jan-May 2011, a further 15% growth has already been achieved.

"The extra airlift that we anticipate having from this market in 2012 will assist our travel agent partners meet their clients requests," she added.

Williams also said that visitor trend information for 2010 revealed that Aussies are visiting Hawaii more frequently, spending more time and staying longer.

Visits to Hawaii's neighbouring islands has increased as a result of HTO's co-operative campaigns with Hawaiian Airlines, wholesale and retail partners, increased airlift and favourable exchange rates. Williams said.

HA executive Glenn Taniguchi said Aussies are "increasingly finding great value in Hawaii vacations, and demand for our services has never been greater."

Due to aircraft availability, HA will also bump up its current four times weekly service to five between 03 Aug and 13 Dec.

SA govt targets Kangaroo Is

A FLURRY of funding announcements by the South Australian government in recent days confirm a strong focus on building tourism to the state's spectacular Kangaroo Island.

Premier Mike Rann and tourism minister John Rau have confirmed a number of investments including \$5m for a new five day walking trail, \$8m for road improvements and \$3.8m for a new passenger terminal at Penneshaw in conjunction with ferry operator Sealink.



Air NZ Tasman traffic surges 13% in Jun

AIR New Zealand yesterday reported a system wide increase in passenger numbers of 2.3% in Jun 2011 compared to the same time 12 months earlier, up to 1,056,000 passengers.

The strongest demand was seen on Tasman/Pacific services, which saw passenger numbers rise 12.7%, aided by a 7.4% increase in capacity, no doubt as a result of electing to continue to operate flights during the ash cloud crisis last month which resulted in other airlines, notably Qantas and Jetstar, axe services.

Domestic passenger numbers were relatively flat compared to last year, up 1.2% to 693,000.
