# Air Australia fleet boost

AIR Australia Airways - formerly known as Strategic Airlines - is set to add four additional planes to its fleet as it grows its domestic and international network.

The expansion will see it take delivery of two more A330-200 aircraft from International Lease

### **Qantas free flights**

PASSENGERS affected by the grounding of the Qantas fleet a month ago have started receiving details of the free flights offered as compensation by the carrier (TD 10 Nov), with emails received overnight giving voucher details and a special booking link at gantas.com/flywithus.

### **Amadeus crashes QF**

**QANTAS** this morning experienced issues with its checkin systems, meaning that in some cases staff had to hand-write boarding passes for passengers.

QF said that the issue was due to a "fault with the Amadeus system, affecting all airlines supplied by Amadeus globally".

The system returned to full operation by 10am, but QF warned travellers to expect delays in Sydney and Brisbane as well as Melbourne, where flights were also impacted by storms.

Finance Corp, as well as relocating two A320s from its European operation to Australia.

Air Australia will shortly launch its new non-stop flights from Brisbane and Melbourne to Hawaii (TD 18 Aug) and has also lodged IASC applications for flights to China and Vietnam.

From the beginning of 2012 the cruise line's Asia-Pacific operations will be headed up by Buhdy Bok, who's currently vice president of Costa Cruises China.

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
#### Irish agents love Aus

AMERICAN Airlines operations will continue unaffacted, despite its parent company AMR Corp filing for Chapter 11 restructuring in the US bankruptcy court.

Qantas has assured travellers that those booked on services operated by its fellow **one**world member should travel as scheduled, despite the move.

through the joint business agreement between the two airlines," a QF spokesman told **TD**.

AA said the reorganisation would allow it to "achieve a cost and debt structure that is competitive in the airline industry" including reducing labour costs which give it a significant disadvantage against competitors.

The move to Chapter 11 came the same day as the retirement of former ceo Gerard Arpey, who has been succeeded by Thomas W. Horton.

Horton said the restructuring would take place as quickly as possible, with AA intending to maintain a strong presence in domestic and international markets "including our cornerstones in Dallas/Fort Worth, Chicago, New York, Miami and Los Angeles".

Normal operations will continue including payment of wages and suppliers and operation of flights.

### Travel pyramid alert

**THE** ACCC has issued a warning about the 'TVI Express' program which offers members "travel certificates" plus commissions for introducing others to the scheme.

The ACCC described it as a "pyramid selling" system, with the scheme "designed to be operated in a way that makes it extremely difficult, if not impossible, for people to redeem their travel certificate".

#### Sri Lanka e-visas

**VISITORS** to Sri Lanka will be able to take advantage of a new online visa processing which will be launched from 01 Jan 2012.

Electronic Travel Authorisations (ETAs) can be processed directly by travellers or via a third party at www.eta.gov.lk, priced at \$US20 for adults, or free for children 12 years and under or transit pax.

Visas will still be offered on arrival at Colombo International Airport during a transition period.



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## Qantas Grp int'l group share slipping

**GOVERNMENT** data released this morning confirms a slide in the international market share of the Qantas Group, now accounting for 26.4% of the total number of passengers carried in Sep 2011.

The figure was one percentage point down on the same month last year, and 0.1 points on Aug.

Qantas Airways held the major share of pax (18.2%), followed by Jetstar (7.9%) & Jetstar Asia (0.3%).



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Singapore Airlines accounted for 9.0% of int'l traffic, holding the same share as last year, then Emirates at 8% (down 0.7 points) and Air New Zealand (-0.1 points) & Jetstar (-0.4 pts) both at 7.9%.

The Department of Infrastructure and Transport report indicated that international scheduled pax traffic continues to swell, up 3.5% year on year to 2.397 million.

Figures are also up 5.8% for the year ending Sep 2011.

Capacity during the month was up 7.0% to 3.149 million, but seat utilisation dropped 2.4 percentage points to 77.0%.

Melbourne saw an 11.6% jump in int'l traffic to 6.35m pax, but at 22.8% of local ports it was nearly half the number passing through Australia's primary hub, Sydney, which had 11.71m movements.

Port Hedland had the greatest increase in int'l passenger traffic among Australian Int'l Airports, up a massive 260.3% to 3,543 pax.

New Zealand, Singapore & the USA were the top three countries that traffic flew to/from during Sep, and the China market had the largest growth, up 45.8% to 1.2m.



Hawaii popular in Sep

HAWAII is proving to be one of the hottest destinations for Aussie travellers this year, with govt airline figures indicating that Hawaiian Airlines flew with a load factor of 96.8% outbound in Sep.

HA's inbound seat utilisation during the month was 93.2%.

Jetstar similarly reported strong loads factors to Hawaii during the month, with 92.6% of outbound seats filled, and 88.7% full returning to Australia.

Delta Air Lines led the charge of transPacific services to mainland USA, with its seat utilisation at 95.6% outbound, followed by Qantas (at 92.2% - which also incl flights to Hawaii), V Australia (91.6%) & United Air Lines (89.5%), today's BITRE data shows.
