WA targets development

WESTERN Australian investors and developers will be incentivised to build new hotels and develop tourism & economic infrastructure by the state govt in a bid to curb a "severe shortage of hotel rooms" in the capital, said WA Minister for Tourism, Kim Hames.



IHG flags new brand

INTERCONTINENTAL Hotels Group has revealed plans to launch a new mid-priced hotel chain in the USA early next year.

Speaking during IHG's annual conference in Las Vegas, the firm's US chief Kirk Kinsell said the move will focus on "mainstream, highfrequency travellers".

He said the addition wouldn't compete with IHG's Holiday Inn, Holiday Inn Express and Hotel Indigo brands, but would give developers the option of building more US hotels and keep their portfolios within the IHG family.

KE boost for SYD, BNE

SEOUL Incheon-based carrier Korean Air is bolstering capacity to Sydney and Brisbane from 01 Jul to 25 Aug next year, according to travel agent GDS displays.

KE's Sydney route will see three new weekly frequencies added, up from daily to 10 weekly, while Brisbane will receive one extra weekly flight, up to six weekly.

"I think they saw the opportunity to let me continue the dream." he said.


The long-awaited historic first commercial flight will operate today from Narita to Hong Kong.



JETSTAR ceo Bruce Buchanan has confirmed speculation of a restructure of its Jetstar Pacific offshoot in Vietnam.

The carrier is in talks with officials in the country which would see a government-owned 70% stake in the domestic airline transferred to the nation's flag carrier, Vietnam Airlines.

Under the plan Qantas would also increase its holding from the current 27% to 30%, but Buchanan stressed that there was still "a lot of water to go under the bridge with these discussions."

If the proposal comes to fruition it would enable VN and Jetstar Pacific to pursue a "two-brand" strategy in the Vietnamese market, similar to the way Qantas and Jetstar operate in Australia.


