



SilverNeedle debuts in Oz

First with the news

A NEW hospitality company has been launched locally following the recent acquisition of Touraust Corporation's Constellation Hotels portfolio of 60 hotels in Australia and New Zealand by Singapore's Nadathur Fareast (*TD* 30 Aug).

SilverNeedle Hospitality is a new intergrated management, development and investment hospitality firm that debuted in Asia this week.

Headquartered in Singapore, SilverNeedle is focused on midupper scale properties into and within Asia and plans to build its profile to a "substantial scale", investing in key urban and resort destinations across the region.

President of SilverNeedle Hosp. Bill Black said the group "kick started" its growth by acquiring Constellation Hotels (including Chifley, Australis Resorts & Hotels and Country Comfort brands in Australia and Sundowner Motels in New Zealand) and will next launch a new accommodation brand, NEXT Hotels & Resorts.

Black said Constellation's "operating expertise, know-how and insights" of the Australian hotel industry would be of "great benefit" to SilverNeedle as it plots future growth.

SilverNeedle aims to have

10,000 rooms in five years, and "plans to invest and develop green-field, brown-field and operating hotels in the region."

The group has earmarked future growth in China, Vietnam, India, Thailand, Indonesia and Sri Lanka.

SilverNeedle has regional offices in Bangkok, Mumbai and Sydney and will open another office in China early next year.

PRINCESS Cruises has ushered in the start of the local summer cruise season today with the arrival today of *Sun Princess* to its new homeport of Brisbane.

The 1990-passenger vessel will be based in Brisbane for the next five months offering sailings to NZ, Asia and the South Pacific.

Sun Princess is the first int'l cruise ship to call Brisbane home, Princess said this morning.

A RANGE of tactical campaigns for travel to Queensland has seen "droves opting for last minute bargains and quick short-break stays" to the Sunshine State, Tourism Queensland says.

TQ acting ceo Leanne Coddington announced this afternoon that the state has had "a bumper start to the spring break", spurred by

QF strike recovery

QANTAS says it successfully minimised the impact of industrial action by the Transport Workers Union yesterday, with nearly 80% of domestic flights departed within 15 minutes of their scheduled departure time.

"More than 14,200 customers were able to get to their destination as planned," QF said.

IATA's grim outlook

THE International Air Transport Assoc. has forecast 2012 will be a "more difficult" year for airlines than 2011, despite upgrading its industry profit to \$6.9 billion.

In Jun the IATA estimated the figure would be \$4.0 billion.

Although there have been improvements, profitability at these levels is a "paltry" 1.2% net margin, IATA boss Tony Tyler said.

Carnival Q3 results

CARNIVAL Corporation reported a \$1.3 billion net income on revenues of \$5.1 billion during the third quarter of 2011 ending 31 Aug, a result "better than anticipated," said chairman and ceo Micky Arison.

Passengers carried over the period increased by 59,000.

IATA anti US tax hike

THE International Air Transport Association director general and ceo Tony Tyler says the US govt's proposal to beef up the 9/11 passenger security fee to help the country reduce its deficit "is absolutely the wrong approach."

The Obama administration has announced plans to hike the security levy from \$US2.50 per segment to as much as \$US5, or \$US10 for a round-trip journey.

In addition, the US wants to lift the round-trip charge an extra \$1 per year from 2013 until 2017.

"Airlines and their passengers are being asked to pay for national security, although it clearly is a responsibility of government.

"Making air travel progressively more expensive is not a sound economic strategy," Tyler said.


