Google HWT/STA case lost

TRAVEL companies will need to be careful what terms they use in internet search engine advertising programs, in the light of a comprehensive ACCC court win against Google this week.

The Full Federal Court yesterday unanimously upheld an ACCC appeal, finding that Google had engaged in "misleading and deceptive conduct" between 2006 and 2008 by allowing Adwords advertisements for particular companies to feature the names or products of their competitors.

Examples cited in the case included an STA Travel online ad which was triggered when users searched online for "Harvey World Travel" or "Harvey World".

An initial case last year found that Google was not responsible for making the false

representations, but this week's appeal dismissed this and instead found in favour of the ACCC. "Google's conduct involved the

use by an advertiser of a competitor's name as a keyword triggering an advertisement for the advertiser with a matching headline," said ACCC chairman Rod Sims.

This was likely to mislead or deceive a consumer searching for information on the competitor, he said, with the judges finding that although the key words are selected by the advertiser "what is critical to the process is the triggering of the link by Google using its algorithms".

Sims said the case makes it clear that Google and other search engine providers will be directly accountable for misleading or deceptive paid search results.

The court said that the appearance of the STA ad in response to an HWT search falsely asserted an affiliation between the companies, and that info about Harvey World Travel could be found on the STA Travel site.

GERMAN carrier airberlin has this month expanded its codeshare partnership with Etihad, with the AB code now appearing on EY flights to Australia as well as Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Indonesia.

New airberlin codeshare routes include EY services from Abu Dhabi to Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane via Singapore as well as Colombo, Jakarta, Karachi, Lahore plus Kuwait and Muscat.








Aspirant carrier anti corp pact

WANNABE Australia domestic and int'l carrier Gold Airways has told the competition regulator it's opposed to the Virgin Australia and Skywest regional alliance, saying it could dilute fly-in fly-out (FIFO) charter competition.

In a submission sent to the ACCC's gm Adjudication Branch, Richard Chadwick, the "aspirant" airline said it believes that "whilst the corporate alliance will bring



some benefits to FIFO corporate travellers generally, it shares the concern of the Western Australia Government [**TD** 05 Mar] that the arrangement has the potential to lessen competition for FIFO bidding which could result in the collapse of smaller but important FIFO carriers."

Gold Airways director Jens Buche argued there is "nothing in this scheme of arrangement to prevent it being applied across the board" by Virgin to other larger FIFO carriers.

Buche called for the final authorisation to have conditions that limit Virgin Australia to just one alliance with a major FIFO carrier at a time.

Additionally, Buche suggested DJ should offer a "non-exclusive" corporate alliance to smaller FIFO carriers throughout the region, excluding Alliance Aviatoin (which has a partnership with Qantas), during the authorisation period.

"That would, in our opinion, produce a fairer playing field," Buche claimed.

Gold was opposed to the Virgin/ Singapore Airlines alliance too.

SOCCER fans, brace yourselves. Real Madrid football legend and former French international Zinedine Zidane, in conjunction with the royal family of the UAE emirate of Ras Al Khaimah have announced the creation of the Real Madrid Resort Island.

Perhaps planning on being ready for the controversial 2022 FIFA World Cup - taking place in nearby Qatar - the football fan's fantasy is set to be situated on an artificial island to be reclaimed from the sea, and the 50ha project will be the first recreational tourism complex designed and created under the Real Madrid football trademark.

Once completed, the complex will contain a theme park, the world's first stadium open to the sea, multiple sport facilities, a residential area, luxury hotels and villas, and a museum dedicated to Real Madrid.

The 50kg egg, designed by London-based William Curley, sold at auction for £7000.

Since applying late last year for Chapter 11 bankruptcy, AMR Corp has lost US\$1.76-billion relating to the company reorganisation more than the \$1.08-billion lost in the entire preceding 11 months of last year.
