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## Amadeus adds car content

**AMADEUS** is claiming an Australian first with the launch today of a partnership with Car Pilots, the country's "most comprehensive private driver and taxi content aggregator".

The move will see Car Pilots content available through the Amadeus Selling Platform, with a dedicated Amadeus Smart Tab linking to the commissionable product and integrating the bookings with the Amadeus PNR.

The new solution enables prepayment of independent private car hire services and taxis, using geo-mapping technology to determine the best route and calculating the fare inclusive of tolls and any extra services.

Amadeus agents can use the Smart Tab to select from a range of vehicles before confirming, paying via credit card and issuing a voucher on the same PNR as hotel and air bookings.

Amadeus IT Pacific md Sari Vahakoski said that booking transfers can be a "pain point" for agents, often needing to be booked by phone and earning zero commission.

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"We believe this new solution will drastically improve travel agency workflow processes as well as offer the opportunity for increased revenue and enhanced customer service," she said.

The PNR integration means the booking data can be easily fed into mid and back office systems, with the Car Pilots solution to roll out by the end of 2012.

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## C'church "open for business"

**CHRISTCHURCH** emphatically declared itself open for business, as each day sees it increasingly ready to welcome visitors back to the rejuvenated South Island city.

Speaking at a Sydney media briefing vesterday, city mayor Bob Parker declared the Christchurch five year central recovery plan was well underway, urging Aussies to "come & see for yourself".

Parker was joined for the unveiling of a blueprint for the city by Christchurch & Canterbury

Tourism ceo Tim Hunter, who added his renewed drive and enthusiasm for the future of the city, describing the plans for the finished product as "a glorious garden city".

Among the developments, Christchurch will receive a brand new visitors centre and theatres plus a sports stadium as a priority from its "rugby-mad" owners and already boasts a new airport terminal which was completed on time despite the earthquakes.

Amidst all the positive plans for the future, Parker reiterated the message that "you cannot get where you're going, without

knowing where you've been," stating that the two earthquakes last year would forever remain in the minds of all residents and be remembered with a special exhibition in the Christchurch museum

The two tremors of Feb and Jun 2011 resulted in the demolition or future renewal of 70% of the CBD's buildings, with a repair bill set to top \$30 billion.

Opening its doors in less than two weeks, Accor's Ibis Christchurch will become the first hotel to reopen in the CBD, which has seen all 155 rooms and public spaces completely refurbished, with hotel manager Tim Dearsley stating that "forward bookings are looking really positive".

The opening of the new Ibis will add 56,000 room nights to the city's annual inventory.

### New JAL 787 routes

JAPAN Airlines has announced details of its fleet plans for 2012, including new routes using 787 *Dreamliner* aircraft from Tokyo Narita direct to San Diego in the USA and Helsinki in Finland.

Narita-San Diego will debut four times per week from 02 Dec, increasing to daily from Mar 2013 - while Narita-Helsinki will start next Mar four times weekly, moving to daily from mid-2013.

Other changes will see JAL increase Narita-Singapore flights from 7 to 14 weekly, with a second daily rotation to be operated using 787s from 28 Oct.

JAL will also boost capacity to New Delhi, Beijing and Shanghai, while on the domestic front, flights will increase on several routes including Haneda-Izumo, Haneda-Sapporo, Sapporo-Sendai and Fukuoka-Miyazaki.

Capacity reductions include Haneda-Okinawa which will drop from 14 to 13 daily flights, and Fukuoka-Kagoshima, down from three to two services per day.

JAL also yesterday announced a reduction in fuel surcharges, with long-haul levies dropping from US\$296 to \$264 per sector.

### More US airline fines

**ROYAL** Jordanian Airlines, EgyptAir and Royal Air Maroc have been fined by the US Department of Transportation for violating expanded passenger protection rules which came into force earlier this year.

RJ has been fined \$70,000 and Royal Air Maroc \$60,000 for not disclosing baggage fees on the first booking screen, while EgyptAir's penalty was \$60,000 for a similar violation as well as not including an assurance that consumers can cancel a reservation without penalty within 24 hours of booking in its customer service plan.

**NEW** Zealand travel agents have been told to ensure they keep enough money in bank accounts to process BSP remittances, after a hiccup earlier this week meant that payments were not deducted on schedule.

IATA has apologised for the inconvenience caused, telling agents to ensure there are sufficient cleared funds to facilitate the withdrawal for the 30 Jul-05 Aug reporting period.

### Breckenridge boost

Dubbed "Peak 6," about 75% of the new terrain will be accessible via a new high-speed six person chairlift and a new fixed-grip lift, with the area expected to be opened for the 2013/14 season.

### **AKL Jul arrival figures**

**AUCKLAND** Airport has reported a slight 1% drop in overall arrival figures for the month of Jul 2012, with big growths in other areas.

The drop was largely attributed to imbalances caused by NZ school holidays seeing high departures in Jun and higher arrivals in Jul as families returned.

The number of Japanese arrivals exploded by 39.7% as nearly 1.7m more visited NZ, signalling strong improvement from the market, although stats are skewed by comparison to last year following natural disasters in both countries.

On the flip side, arrivals from the UK plummeted 25.4%, with no reason given for the slide.

Queenstown Airport saw big jumps in arrivals from domestic and international traffic, posting 20.6% & 30.1% spikes respectively.

### Cambodia update

**THE** Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade has reissued its travel advice for Cambodia, with new info about an outbreak of Hand. Foot and Mouth disease.

The advisory, which remains at the lowest 'Exercise normal safety precautions' level, also now states that Australians must have at least six months' passport validity when arriving in Cambodia on an electronic visa.

Chipchase said the decision by producers to launch the show in Sydney confirmed the city's status as a major events destination.



Celebrity Interview with Shane & Andrew - winners of The Amazing Race Australia 2012



Australia was captivated each week by the exploits of 11 unique teams racing around the world and back in the quest for a \$250,000 prize. ### Air insurance cap up

**TRANSPORT** minister Anthony Albanese has today introduced new federal legislation which will significantly increase the payout available to air accident victims on domestic flights in Australia.

The bill lifts the previous \$500,000 cap on payouts to \$725,000, with Albanese saying that "while Australia has a proud aviation safety record, it is important we continue to strengthen protections for people flying domestically".

The level of mandatory insurance for airlines is also being increased, to ensure that adequate moneys are available for the compensation of accident victims and their families.

The cap has not been adjusted since 1994, with the move bringing Australia closer into line with the Montreal Convention.

"The Bill continues this government's comprehensive overhaul of consumer protection arrangements for airline passengers announced in Australia's first Aviation White Paper," Albanese said.
