Two JTG execs to leave

JETSET Travelworld Limited this morning told shareholders that two of its senior managers will be leaving the firm, and have been "determined as Good Leavers".

The unnamed pair together hold 476,499 shares in the company, received when it merged with Stella Travel in Oct 2010 (**TD** 30 Jul 2010).

At that time about 40 senior Stella staff transferred their shares in Stella to the new entity.

CEO Peter Lacaze told **TD** the departures were "both quite straightforward and obviously friendly," and based on the shares originally issued, one of the leavers has 381,199 shares and the other has 95,300.

Under the terms of the escrow deed with Europe Voyager NV, socalled "good leavers" are able to take their shares when they depart, with today's ASX update confirming that the 476,499 shares will be released effective from 31 Jan 2012. after some years running Melbourne TSAX member Excell Travel & Cruise.

The new operation in Penguin is called House of Travel and Cruise and is one of six new agencies admitted to the TCF since 16 Dec.

Robyn Sinfield is well known to the industry, having been the first ever winner of the AVIS Travel Agent Scholarship of Excellence in 1997 as well as receiving many other cruise industry accolades.

Last month she was also appointed to a new P&O Advisory Board which aims to strengthen the cruise line's trade relations.

Bali tattoo warning

AUSTRALIAN travellers who recently got a tattoo or body piercing while on holiday in Bali recently are being advised to have a blood test for HIV.

The call comes after WA Health advised that a returned traveller had tested positive to HIV, with a tattoo obtained in Bali considered the most likely source of infection.

Indonesian health authorities are also investigating the incident. HIV is soaring in Bali, with estimates that 25% of prostitutes on the island are HIV-positive and a 19% year-on-year increase in HIV infections in Bali during 2010.



Turner takes on mines

FLIGHT Centre ceo Graham Turner has flagged legal action against the Qld government and/ or mining company OGL Resources if a proposed coalmine south-west of Ipswich is opened, according to the *Financial Review*.

ONLINE agent wholesaler Destinations of the World has shut down its local operations, about five years after establishing a dedicated Australian office.

DOTW, which also launched a domestic product range in 2009, now says that "where Australia was concerned it made the most sense financially to have sales, operations, IT and finance handled from our head office in Dubai".

DOTW Global Sales Director, Phil Dickinson, told **TD** last night that despite the pullout "we are still very serious about continuing to develop our Australia business

More of LLA for Merlin

LIVING and Leisure Australia this morning advised the stock exchange that its suitor, Merlin Entertainments, now holds 49.22% of the company.

The friendly takeover of the ski resort, treetop walk and aquarium operator has a 90% minimum acceptance condition.

\$60k DOT ad fine

THE US Department of Transportation has levied yet another hefty fine on an airline for deceptive price advertising.

AirTran Airways has been hit with a US\$60,000 penalty over a promotion during 2011 where it advertised \$59 one-way fares on a number of websites.

"The advertisement noted that additional taxes, fees and exclusions would apply, but with no information on the type or amount of taxes or fees," the DOT said in a statement.

Consumers who clicked through on the ads were taken to the AirTran website, where details of the extra costs appeared at the bottom of the page in fine print.

From 26 Jan the US law will become even stricter, with all taxes and fees required to be included in every advertised fare similar to the rules in Australia. both inbound and outbound". The company was established in 1993 as a dedicated B2B global travel industry wholesaler, and says it serves over 150,000 travel agents worldwide, offering 95,000 hotels in 170 countries generating more than two million room nights per annum.

DOTW is also actively developing new XML connectivity with a range of suppliers, with seven currently live and 18 more in the pipeline, along with plans to add car hire and cruise product.

In recent years a number of rival Australian-based agent-friendly wholesalers have arisen including Travel Agents Nexus and Excite Holidays, while Expedia's Travel Agents Affiliate Program has also seen a strong local take-up.

THE Australian Tourism Export Council this morning advised members of the death of Michele King, wife of ATEC chairman John King, after a long illness.

Maldives spas reopen

THE government of the Maldives has reversed a ban on spa treatments announced earlier this week, with recognition that it was beginning to significantly impact the country's tourism.

The relaxation is also likely to see proposed bans on the sale of alcohol and pork also dropped.

A number of luxury properties ignored the ban, including those operated by the Six Senses group which said it was "doing its utmost to clarify with the authorities the nature of Six Senses Spas as a professionally managed business with the highest international standards.

"We understand that the instruction of the Ministry is with regards to establishments offering services that break the law," said Six Senses Maldives md Antony Paton.
