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Jewel pax overboard

P&O Cruises Australia yesterday confirmed a female passenger on *Pacific Jewel* had been reported missing by family members on Sun night while the ship sailed from Lifou to Noumea on day eight of a Pacific Islands cruise.

The cruise line said a complete search of *Jewel* failed to locate the elderly woman and that a review of onboard CCTV footage of a balcony area indicated that she had gone overboard.

Pacific Jewel searched through the night for the passenger and New Caledonian authorities assisted with an air search at first light on Mon morning but failed to find the passenger.

The ocean search meant *Jewel* was unable to make a scheduled port of call at Noumea.

Concordia still salvageable - Carnival

CARNIVAL Corporation says it's assessing damage to the Costa Concordia to see how long the ship will be out of service, after its catastrophic accident off the coast of Italy on Sun (TD yest).

In a stock exchange statement Carnival said it expects the vessel to be out of service for the current financial year to 30 Nov.

The cruise giant confirmed it has insurance coverage for damage to the vessel with a deductible of

approximately US\$30 million, as well as insurance for third party personal liability again subject to a deductible of US\$10m.

The company self-insures for loss of use of the vessel which is estimated to cost US\$85m-\$95m for the financial year to 30 Nov.

Yesterday Carnival Corporation shares plummeted more than 16% in the wake of the accident which saw the ship hit rocks causing a massive evacuation and the death of several pax.


AIRASIA X's new Sydney route is probably the worst kept secret ever in the travel industry.

SQ A380 FRA to JFK

SINGAPORE Airlines yesterday flew its inaugural daily Airbus A380 service between Singapore & Frankfurt and onwards to New York City's JFK, replacing the existing Boeing 747-400 aircraft used on the route.

The new aircraft will add 25% more seat capacity daily on the route and will make it the 9th and 10th cities that SQ operates its superjumbos to.

Last week Singapore Airlines took delivery of its 15th A380, the first superjumbo delivery by the aircraft manufacturer in 2012.

MEANWHILE SIA has reported increases in capacity, passenger kilometres and pax carried for the month of Dec, however there was a 1.1 percentage point decrease in load factors, down to 79.6%.

The largest drop in pax loads was in East Asia with a decrease of 4.6 points to 78.8% followed by West Africa & Africa down 2.7pts to 76.1%, while the South West Pacific fell 1.3 points to 84.7%.

EK breaks SYD curfew

EMIRATES may have incurred a Sydney Airport fine last week, after the late departure of EK413 from Sydney to Dubai on 08 Jan. EK has confirmed that the flight

was also forced to operate via Bandaranaike International Airport in Sri Lanka for refuelling, after a thunderstorm in Sydney impacted fuel delivery.

"In order to limit the inconvenience caused by the weather-imposed delay to Emirates' passengers the decision was made, prior to departure, to operate the flight via Sri Lanka," the carrier told TD.

"Once the thunderstorm had subsided the aircraft was cleared by Air Traffic Control for departure, however as this was beyond the imposed curfew at Sydney the airline may incur a fine," a statement added.

New ZQN airport ceo

SCOTT Paterson has been named as the new chief executive of Queenstown Airport in New Zealand.

Paterson will relocate to ZQN from his current position as ceo of Port of Portland in Vic, replacing Steve Sanderson who is moving from Queenstown to head up Wellington Airport.

WA golfing gold

THE upcoming Perth International Golf Championship, to be held at Lake Karrinyup Country Club in Oct, will be Australia's richest tournament with prize money of \$2 million.

That outstrips the \$1.5m available for each of the Emirates Australian Open, Australian PGA and JBWere Masters events.

The WA govt has also allocated \$3.6m over three years for top golfer appearance fees.

JOSEPHINE Ridge, the executive director and co-ceo of the China Southern Airlines-sponsored Sydney Festival, has been appointed to the role of creative director of the Melbourne Festival and will take up the new role effective 30 Apr.

Ridge has been involved with the Sydney Festival since 2003.

Record for Frankfurt

FRANKFURT Airport in Germany handled 56.44 million passengers during 2011, a 6.5% year on year increase and a new record for the key Lufthansa hub.

The growth looks set to continue, with Frankfurt opening its fourth runway in Oct last year.

"Melbourne's population is anticipated to overtake Sydney's in the next 20 years, and we anticipate that Melbourne Airport - Tullamarine - will be Australia's largest international airport," James said.

The Victorian capital's other major airport is at Avalon.

Airberlin transfers

GERMAN carrier airberlin has this week announced the introduction of limousine transfers for business class passengers on its new flights between Germany and Abu Dhabi.

The carrier has also debuted a new cabin configuration on its A330-200 aircraft, with 20 business class and 279 economy class seats and a new in-flight entertainment system.

Airberlin's entire long-haul fleet will be retrofitted with the new cabins by Mar, with the announcements following the recent significant alliance between the German airline and Etihad (**TD** 19 Dec).

CX pax up 7.9% in Dec

CATHAY Pacific Airways and sister carrier Dragonair carried 2.46m passengers in Dec, a year-on-year increase of 7.9%.

Capacity rose 8.7% and the overall passenger load factor fell 0.5 points to 79.6%.

Full year passenger numbers rose 2.9% to 27.6 million, while capacity increased 9.2%.

However there was a significant drop in cargo and mail traffic in Dec, which was down 11.9%.

AFTA UPDATE

The latest insights from AFTA's Chief Executive, Jayson Westbury

In this past week the travel industry has very unexpectedly and very sadly lost one of the industry's great personalities in Wayne Tregaskis.

Wayne was very well known to me and over the past four years had become a good friend and a person who I valued greatly. He was the type of guy that would not let the little things worry him and was always watching out for his mates.

Wayne's World as he knew it: was a fantastic place and even if there was a drama or two going on his world, you would not know about it.
