Air Pacific 'business as usual'

FIJIAN flag carrier Air Pacific insists there is no change to its operations after the Fijian govt unilaterally outlawed what it says was the "effective control" of FJ by Qantas (*TD* breaking news).

Qantas owns 46% of the airline, but according to the self-appointed Bainimarama govt, QF has "supermajority and veto rights over significant areas of the company," including key appointments, the budget, new air routes, employee incentive schemes and "numerous other key areas of oversight, control and decision making."

The new Fijian aviation decree issued this week orders that all air carriers registered in Fiji must be under the "substantial ownership and effective control" of Fijian citizens.

In a formal statement the govt also complained that despite QF's "veto power" over Air Pacific's operations and business decisions it also competes directly via its Sydney-Nadi Jetstar flights.

However QF denied many of the claims made by the Fijian government, with a spokesperson

telling **TD** "Qantas does not have veto power over Air Pacific's operational decisions, nor do we have effective control over the airline. We are a minority shareholder".

Air Pacific downplayed the impact of the move, describing it as a "shareholder matter".

An FJ spokesperson told **TD** "our board, our business partners and our great team of professionals continue to work together to revitalise, modernise and ensure the future success of our airline".

Garden Island knock-back

CARNIVAL Australia has blasted the latest govt review on Sydney Harbour's long term cruise ship access, after an Independent Review released today concluded that greater cooperation between cruise and navy operations at Garden Island "are essentially incompatible."

Minister for Defence Stephen Smith said the Hawke Review had determined a provision of guaranteed shared access to existing berths at the site "cannot be achieved without adversely impacting on naval operations."

The review suggested one shortterm option was a 'dolphin' berth at the O'seas Passenger Terminal, and a similar "more permanent" dolphin berth close to the shoreline at Athol Bay.

Carnival Australia has been lobbying for some time for the govt to permit greater access to Garden Island to accommodate the overload of ships during the peak cruise season.

It labelled the outcome as "a disappointment for Sydney and for Australian tourism" and "set a course for further reviews and delays", denying certainty to international cruise operators.

"Leadership at the highest levels of government is essential or Australia risks putting a brake on the standout success of the tourism sector in a difficult economic environment," Carnival Australia ceo Ann Sherry said.

Sherry said the dolphin mooring wasn't a viable solution.

Air NZ drops Beijing

AIR New Zealand will suspend its twice weekly services from Auckland to Beijing, effective 30 Jun, following a review of services operating to China.

The review will see Air NZ put a greater focus on its Shanghai hub, supported by a new fifth weekly service (from 04 Jul), with the carrier planning to move to a daily operation by early next year.

Air NZ group gm International Airline, Christopher Luxon said the airline still sees Beijing as an "important and growing market" but will rely on the Shanghai-Beijing services of Star Alliance partner, Air China, to transport its clients to the Chinese capital.

EVA to Star Alliance

TAIWANESE carrier EVA Air has this afternoon been accepted by the Chief Executive Board of Star Alliance as a future member airline, to be mentored during the process by Air China.

QF Mackay Lounge

QANTAS yesterday launched its new flagship Regional Lounge in Mackay, Queensland, featuring an expanded lounge space, seating for 91 guests, and signature artwork representing the area.

The opening coincides with the introduction of new QantasLink Boeing 717 services ex Brisbane which began this week.

The lounge is open to Platinum and Gold Qantas Frequent Flyers and Qantas Club members.

ATEC Symposium full steam ahead

THE Australian Tourism Export Council says it's ironing out a number of issues surrounding speculation its annual Symposium would not be held this year, and is close to issuing the program of events for the conference.

Problems concerning the venue appear to have resolved and the event will proceed in May on the Sunshine Coast as planned, md Felicia Mariani said yesterday.

Among the activities slated to be held at the event will be a series of Masterclasses, as well as smaller group sessions to provide attendees with more hands-on &



in-depth learning opportunities.

Feedback from previous events has resulted in the return of the popular Market Stream sessions.

A highlight of the event will be the 40th anniversary celebration of ATEC's involvement with the tourism export industry.

T-QUAL partnership

TOURISM Minister Martin Ferguson has spoken in support of new tourism partnerships forged with the support of Govt grants under the T-QUAL scheme.

The pact is the first formed between the Yugambeh Museum, Language and Heritage Research Centre in Qld and four of the region's tourism operators in the Jaran Dance Troupe, Kalwun Dreaming Tours, International Park Tours and Dreamworld.

Under the plan, a joint effort of \$176,000 from the Museum and an \$88,000 govt grant will aim to help identify and develop new tourism opportunities, with an ultimate goal of tripling the Aboriginal tourism spend in the region from \$3m to \$10m over the next three years.

Intrepid Gorilla pledge

INTREPID Travel says it will absorb the US\$250 price increase in gorilla permits enforced by the Rwandan govt (*TD* 30 Jan) for bookings in 2012, a promise it believes is a first for the trade.

From 01 Jun, individual gorilla permits will rise to US\$750.

Bookings made before 31 May for travel this year will also get a 10% tour discount.

"This is one small way we thank our passengers," Intrepid Travel md Geoff Manchester said.

The adventure tour operator has 129 departures spread over seven tours visiting the gorillas from Jun to the end of 2012.

Celebrity back in 2013

CELEBRITY Cruises has said its *Celebrity Solstice* and *Celebrity Millennium* will both cruise in Australian waters for their second consecutive season in 2013-14.

"Together the two ships will offer Australians a 'modern luxury' style of cruising which is quite distinct from anything else based in this region," said Adam Armstrong, Celebrity spokesman.

Air India on again?

FAIRFAX Media has refueled talks about a possible launch of Air India (AI) services to either Sydney or Melbourne using 787 *Dreamliner* aircraft from as early as Oct this year (*TD* 23 Dec).

A report in *The Sydney Morning Herald* today indicates NSW premier Barry O'Farrell has held talks with AI, Jet Airways and civil aviation authorities to entice air links between India and Sydney.

Al's plans of flying to Australia were exclusively revealed by **TD** three years ago (**TD** 21 Jun 2010).




