
Oil price slams SQ

SINGAPORE Airlines this morning reported a 69% slump in full year profit, with an overall result of SG\$336m for 2011-12.

Group revenue rose 2% or \$333m to \$14.86b with passenger numbers up 3.6%, but there was a 29% increase in fuel costs and the weak global economy also contributed to lower yields.

The fourth quarter was particularly difficult, with SQ reporting an operating loss of \$5m for the three months, compared to a \$166m profit for the corresponding previous period.

Looking forward, Singapore Airlines said that "promotional activities necessitated by intense competition amongst airlines are expected to place downward pressure on passenger yields".



EK/flydubai seek ACCC OK

EMIRATES and its low-cost sister carrier flydubai have requested ACCC authorisation for an Affiliation Agreement which will see "an extensive range of cooperative programs and coordinated activities", Travel Daily can exclusively reveal.

The application envisages that the carriers will jointly conduct marketing and advertising, offer interline and codeshare products, share revenue and provide frequent flyer rewards schemes.

Virgin/Skywest tick

THE Australian Competition and Consumer Commission says that the formal five-year approval of a Corporate Alliance between Virgin Australia and Skywest (TD breaking news) will boost competition and potentially lower prices for clients.

The deal, which received an interim OK in Jan, "is likely to result in public benefits such as enhanced products and services available to corporate customers," according to ACCC chairman Rod Sims.

It will allow the airlines to offer bundled air passenger transport services to corporate customers seeking an integrated suite of charter, domestic and international air services.

Sims said it would allow better competition from the airlines "in competition with Qantas and its affiliates".

Both airlines are ultimately owned by the Dubai government but the structure does not neatly fit within the definition of the Australian Competition and Consumer Act, meaning that ACCC clearance is being requested "to obtain legal certainty".

The carriers are seeking interim authorisation to "enable the joint deployment, planning, marketing and sale of the new services to commence as soon as possible".

The pact wil allow EK to offer a "seamless series of connections from Australia via Dubai to a greater number of destinations in the Middle East, Africa, Europe and Asia" by purchasing a single fare in Australia from Emirates, rather than two separate tickets.

Submissions on the application are due by 24 May 2012 to adjudication@accc.gov.au.
