THE boss of Middle Eastern carrier Qatar Airways has revealed the massive new US\$15.5 billion Doha Int'l Airport now won't open until December 2013, a year behind schedule.

The facility is nearly complete, he said in Belgrade overnight, but the airline has been let down by a German firm who defaulted on a US\$250 million contract to build premium lounges.

"We have now contracted an Italian company to do the job, and the German firm will soon be getting a letter from our lawyers seeking half-a-billion dollars in compensation," said Al Baker.
