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





### **TICNSW Wilton study**

**TOURISM** Industry Council NSW general manager Andrew Jefferies has called on Federal Transport Minister Anthony Albanese to release the results of a scoping study into the viability of Wilton as a second Sydney Airport site.

The study was commissioned by the Minister back in Jul (TD 23 Jul) and was expected to take six months to complete.

Jefferies said ongoing uncertainty about the unsuitability of the site was not in the state's interests.

### **CA** expands network

AIR China is expanding services to Germany, announcing it will launch direct flights between the cities of Chengdu and Frankfurt from 19 May.

The service, which sees Chengdu become the third Chinese city with direct air links to Frankfurt, will operate three times weekly, utilising Airbus A330-200 aircraft.

**MEANWHILE**, the carrier has also decided to upgrade its New York service to larger B777-300ER aircraft, upping frequencies from seven to 11 weekly from 31 Mar.

### **Qld tour desk review**

**QUEENSLAND** tourism minister Jann Stuckey has announced the development of a new Code of Practice, aiming to improve the relationship between tour desks and tour operators.

The move follows a review conducted by independent consultant Ian Kean, which included recommendations relating to tour desk commissions.

The Qld Tourism Industry Council has been asked to set up an Implementation Task Force, with local consultation meetings planned for Cairns, Airlie Beach and on the Gold Coast.

Kean's report (**TD** 18 Jan 2012) looked into claims that some tour desks were seeking commissions of up to 45% of ticket prices.

Stuckey said the industry-led creation of the Code of Practice was a preferable option to the alternative of "more legislation and red tape".

QTIC ceo Daniel Gschwind said his organisation would aim to develop the new code quickly "so industry can begin to adopt it as the usual way of doing business".
