



Aussie US visits up 8%

THE US Dept of Commerce has today reported an 8% yearon-year spike in the number of Australians entering the United States during the month of Apr.

At 94,560 visits, Apr had the highest tally of Aussie arrivals so far in 2013 - over 11,000 more than in Mar.

Over the same period, five of the USA's top 10 source markets (UK, Mexico, France, Germany and Japan) reported declines, driving overall international visit numbers down 2%.

For the first four months of 2013, Australian arrival figures into the US are up 6% on the corresponding period, to 318,000.

Aussie room rates fall

SUN-CHASING tourists heading overseas to escape the Australian winter resulted in average room rates declining in nearly every Aussie city this past winter, data from HotelsCombined reveals.

The worst hit city was Adelaide, with the median rate falling 20%, followed by Perth at 17%, while 24 of the Top 100 regional ports popular with Aussies last winter fell off the list entirely in 2013.

Room rates in Christchurch saw the largest gain, up 71% to \$188.

Arrivals flying at ZQN

QUEENSTOWN Airport posted a massive 64.7% year-on-year spike in visitor arrivals in Sep, with the jump largely attributed to increased Australian services.

Both Jetstar & Air New Zealand added capacity to Australian east-coast cities, which in turn led to a 78% jump in aircraft movements.

The results were reflected in an overall business update issued by parent facility Auckland Airport, who itself posted a 6% increase in arrivals for the month.

Arrivals from China recorded a climb of 49.2% year-on-year both on direct flights and as a result on onward traffic from Australia.

ETIHAD Airways and Jet Airways have been given a green light to begin a reciprocal codeshare agreement on flights between the UAE & USA, and India & USA.

Need for regional htls

DEVELOPING & investing in new hotel infrastructure in regional centres should be a key concern for government and industry, Tourism Accommodation Australia md Rodger Powell has stressed.

Speaking at the Australian Regional Tourism Convention in Margaret River, Powell said climbing costs and a persistently high AUD has led to flat growth over the last five years.

He singled out Queensland as deserving of praise for identifying regional areas as having potential to develop casino resorts capable of attracting Asian travellers.

"Such initiatives are to be applauded, as are operators who invest in upgrading and refreshing their own product, but this is difficult when demand is flat and costs are increasing," Powell said.
