Robb to push QF stake buy

AUSTRALIAN trade minister Andrew Robb has confirmed he will raise the issue of foreign investment in Oantas with Emirates ceo Sheikh Ahmed bin Saeed Al Maktoum, during a visit to Dubai this week.

Speaking at a trade summit in the emirate yesterday, Robb said that foreign ownership of Qantas was the "only solution" to get the carrier over its current hurdles, according to Arabian Business.

New Club Med resort

However a Qantas spokesperson downplayed any deal, tellling TD that both OF and EK "have been clear that our partnership doesn't extend to equity".

EK president Tim Clark said last year that buying a stake in Qantas was "not on the table" but that the carrier was keeping a close eye on the situation (TD 16 Dec).

MEANWHILE, Minister Robb said Australia was looking at adding Gulf nations to a possible visa-waiver scheme to encourage greater visitation from the region.

Speaking on the sidelines of the summit, Robb also confirmed that Australia was looking to extend the age for applicants to the Working Holiday Visa program.

Hainan flights for Avalon

SCHEDULED long-haul

international passenger flights are likely to operate between China and Victoria's Avalon Airport within the next 18 months, under a Memorandum of Understanding between Australian transport firm Linfox and HNA group.

The HNA group has extensive transport and tourism operations, with interests including a fleet of more than 330 aircraft operated by carriers such as Hainan Airlines and Hong Kong Airlines along with major freight operations.

The deal was witnessed by Prime Minister Tony Abbott in Shanghai on Fri, with the MoU seeing Linfox and HNA cooperate to "build an integrated logistics network in major cities in China and Australia to provide one-stop air/sea/land transport services".

As well as its extensive road transport network, Linfox is the owner of Avalon Airport in Geelong, and the MoU will see it assist HNA "to start an aviation service between Australia and China within 18 months using Avalon Airport as a base," according to a statement issued by Vic Premier Denis Napthine, who was also present at the signing ceremony.

The partners would contribute jointly towards the creation of an international terminal and associated infrastructure at Avalon Airport, the MoU states.

Cargo is also seen as a key opportunity, with the airport's executive chairman, David Fox, saying the agreement "heralds a major step forward in realising my father Lindsay Fox's vision of giving Asian markets ready access to Australian fresh produce".

HNA Group's tourism operations is a major package tour operator, with the inbound market from China seen as having enormous future potential for the tourism and hospitality sector in Geelong.

QANTAS has advised that it will undertake an update on the Qantas Industry Sales website, with the process commencing at 6pm this Thu 17 Apr and complete at noon on Wed 23 Apr.

During this period, it will not be possible to conduct online name corrections, as well as a number of other site functions such as Registration, Forgotten Password, Change Password and Amend Agency Details.

The QIC will be closed over the Easter long weekend, with name correction requests available by calling QIC directly on Tue 22 and Wed 23 Apr.

VIRGIN Australia has launched a new "Space Class" competition, in which members of its Velocity frequent-flyer program can win an upgrade to travel into space aboard Virgin Galactic.

NEXT time your flight is delayed, spare a thought for passengers aboard a recent Cathay Pacific flight from New York to Hong Kong, which included a "15hour unscheduled layover" in Zhuhai, China.

According to *NBC News* CX 831 departed JFK on 29 Mar for the 16 hour journey to HKG, but a big storm during its final approach caused the aircraft to be diverted to Zhuhai.

Unfortunately, Chinese officials didn't allow anyone off the 777 when it landed, and the pilots and crew were unable to continue the flight because they ran out of cockpit hours.

Fortunately, supplies were allowed on board and a replacement crew was promptly dispatched by CX, but rather than fly to Zhuhai they had to travel by ferry to Macau and then drive an hour to the city.

The flight finally arrived in Zhuhai at 2pm on 31 Mar about 34 hours after departure.

Lizard looks intact

LIZARD Island Resort in Far North Queensland remains closed for an indeterminate period, after sustaining some structural damage as a result of Cyclone Ita when it passed over the region last Fri night.

Management have conducted an initial assessment of the impact, which indicates that "many of the buildings look to be intact" but extensive vegetation damage is limiting accessibility.

The island was closed on Wed as the storm approached, with all 63 staff and 31 guests transferred to the mainland due to the severe warning levels.

Space Ships vs Star Ships

THE inception of Scenic Tours Group's new river cruise brand enables the firm to tap further into the surging market, which is showing no sign of abating.

In fact, Scenic founder Glen Moroney believes the newly launched Emerald Waterways has the potential to expand rapidly.

Speaking with Travel Daily this week in Europe, Moroney suggests river cruising is only in its "infancy", equivalent to where ocean cruising was in the 1980s.

So why introduce a potential competing river cruise brand to Scenic Tours' 'Space Ships' which launched back in 2008?

In Moroney's opinion, there is ample room for more players and that there are distinctive points of difference between his 'Space Ships' and Emerald's 'Star Ships'.

"Emerald Waterways is not meant to compete with Scenic," he emphasised.

Besides a price-point difference of near 15-20%, Star Ships have fewer inclusions and excursions.

"Space Ships are at the absolute top end of the river cruise market & will continue to go further up."

But the sheer scale of inclusions offered on Scenic compared to its rivals made it difficult to compete on a level playing field.

Scenic includes activities, electric assisted bikes, GPS navigation self guided tours, butler service & all inclusive beverages for all guests with six red & six white local and international wines offered

at dinner, individual transfers, exclusive Enrich experiences and four restaurants onboard, he said.

Emerald Waterways was developed to offer Scenic Tours Group the ability to give those rivals a run for their money.

Emerald Sky and Emerald Star's proposition is one restaurant & drinks provided only with meals.

Daily shore excursions are also included but guests can enhance land touring through Emerald Waterways' pay-as-you-go 'Discover More' program.

Moroney described Emerald as a 5-star ship with 4-star inclusions.

"There is nothing dumbed down or cheap about it.

"It's got all the features including a pool, cinema, gym, wellness room, all the amenities & big onebedroom suites, but it doesn't have a whole list of inclusions & extras which Scenic offers."

He suspects Emerald Waterways has the ability to lure guests that are "a little more active and want a bit more freedom."

"We will market the product for what it is and what it does and if it appeals to a younger audience that is great, but it certainly is not designed to develop a totally new market."

He said Emerald has potential for massive growth in the future, with 92% of cabins in its debut 2014 season already sold out.

"My guess is there will be many more to come because this is at the level of the volume market."

Star godmother TBA

INSIDE one month before it commences operation, Emerald Waterways second ship Emerald Star is Godmother-less.

Emerald Waterways founder Glen Moroney says a formal announcement as to who may be named as Star's godmother will come "in due course."

Last week, UK celebrity/actress Twiggy was bestowed with the honour of christening sister-ship Emerald Sky in Amsterdam.

Scenic cruise spend

A CONSERVATIVE figure of €80 million (AU\$118 million) has been invested by Scenic Tours Group on the Australian company's cruise ship fleet in 2014.

MD for Scenic Tours Group Glen Moroney estimated the average price of his four newest ships - Emerald Sky & Emerald Star under the Emerald Waterways brand and Scenic Gem & Scenic Jade 'Space Ships' - was 'give or take' around €20 million each equivalent to AU\$29.6 million.

MEANWHILE, a shortage of slots at ship building yards in Europe is the prime factor hindering Scenic Tours Group's rapid expansion of its river cruise fleet.

On top of the four new vessels this year, the company will add another five in 2015 (TD Fri), however that number could have been seven, says managing director Glen Moroney.

"I wanted to build another for each brand, but I'll leave that until 2016," he exclusively revealed to Travel Daily.

Moroney said by 2016 the Scenic Tours Group ship fleet would swell to 17 vessels, and possibly "23 or 24" by 2017.



GOL TAP codeshare

LATIN American low-cost carrier GOL has announced a codeshare and frequent flyer program agreement with Star Alliance member TAP Portugal.

TAP operates more than 70 weekly flights from Portugal to Sao Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, Campinas, Belo Horizonte, Brasilia, Porto Alegre, Salvador, Natal, Fortaleza and Recife.

The pact is still pending approval by authorities in Brazil and Portugal, and will initially allow TAP to include its codes on GOL flights, enabling connections to other Brazilian destinations.

Port Douglas reopens

BUSINESSES in the main street of Port Douglas have resumed normal operations following Cyclone Ita which hit the region this weekend, with ferry and reef operators reopening from today.

Confirmed by Six Flags Entertainment Corporation, the new attraction will be located in a new precinct under development in Jebel Ali which will contain a variety of new theme parks.

Call to close down LCY

A REPORT by UK economic think tank New Economic Foundation has recommended London City Airport close down for the site to be redeveloped into new housing, commercial and industrial sites.

According to the report, flights to London City could shift to Heathrow, Gatwick or Stansted. London City Airport occupies 500,000 square metres "at the heart of London", with its direct contribution to the economy less than a fifth of the nearby ExCeL

Exhibition and Conference Centre. However an airport spokesman said closure would cost 2,000 jobs with a £750m economic impact.

Record visits to USA

OFFICIAL full-year visitor arrival statistics for the USA have been released by the US Department of Commerce, with numbers from Australia up 7% year-on-year to a new record of 1.21 million.

Australia rounded out the Top Ten source markets for the US, while the total result for the year closed at 69.8 million, a further three million than the year prior.

Maximising pub hols

EXPEDIA has reported a 70% increase in long-haul enquiries for the Easter holidays by travellers taking the three days between Easter and the Anzac Day long weekend as an extra long break.

According to the OTA, one in ten Aussies have taken next week's three working days off, mostly by those aged in the 25-34 bracket.

USA, Europe and Asia have been the most popular destinations for the longer break, with triple-digit increases in bookings to France (+330%), Italy (+250%) and the UK (+140%).

Interest in Phuket is up 250%, with Bali up 130%, Hanoi by 90% & domestic also performing well.



A COURT in Italy has upheld a legal challenge from Italian airline association Assaereo blocking Emirates from operating its new route from Milan to New York.

According to a statement from Assaereo after the verdict, fifth-freedom passenger services cannot be operated by a non-EU carrier between two countries other than its registered base, which in this case is Italy and the United States.

Emirates commenced operating the Milan-New York route in Oct last year (TD 02 Oct) as an add-on sector to its service from Dubai, with the carrier saying it may lodge an appeal on the decision.
