QF availability shifts to LHR

QANTAS has adjusted its availability displays for flights to Europe, and is now suggesting that travel agents route their clients travelling to the continent via London Heathrow rather than directly through its Dubai hub.

The move shows a preference by Qantas to put passengers on its own aircraft, despite the "metal-neutral" Emirates alliance.

Despite proudly touting its one stop connections to a host of European destinations as part of its EK partnership, GDS screens and other booking portals are now suggesting that travellers should travel to destinations such as Rome in two stops - one in Dubai and the other in London,

The change has also impacted availability displays for flights to London itself, with the *Airline Hub Buzz* website highlighting an Amadeus screen suggesting that Qantas bookings from Brisbane to Heathrow should be routed as a two stop journey through Dubai via Melbourne or Sydney, rather than on the direct Emirates flight from the Queensland capital.

The QF codeshare flights with Emirates have not been removed from the GDS, but require bypass commands, meaning agents have to look harder to book the onestop Europe routes.

Webjet Exclusives launch

ONLINE travel agency Webjet has moved into the "deals" market with the debut of its new Webjet Exclusives product (*TD* breaking news) - a range of shortterm fixed price travel offers.

Foreshadowed earlier this year (**TD** 13 Feb), the new division is headed up by Paul Ryan who was formerly Vic/Tas exec gm for Flight Centre and more recently gm of travel for group buying operator Scoopon.

Webjet ceo John Guscic said the move was a "material extension of its Australian business".

"Webjet Exclusives offers directly-contracted travel products including hotels, resorts, land and air packages, tours and cruises," he said.

Guscic said that in contrast to other deals sites, all offers featured on Webjet Exclusives are exclusively created, negotiated directly with suppliers and not available elsewhere.

The initiative also features a "powerful and unique" 21 day no-questions-asked money-back guarantee, allowing customers to request a refund for any reason.

ITG Hawaii forum

New product & brand marketing initiatives are set to be unveiled at the event, with Hawaiian Airlines the main airline sponsor. The expansion is available via a new tab on the Webjet website, which enables users to subscribe to receive further offers.

Existing subscribers must sign up separately to get Webjet Exclusives emails.

Launch product includes both domestic and international deals, with local suppliers including Palazzo Versace on the Gold Coast which starts at \$469 for one night including an upgrade, breakfast, a lunch or dinner for two and a complimentary bottle of sparkling wine for bookings of three nights or longer.

It's claimed to be a saving of up to 66% on normal pricing.

International Webjet Exclusives include hotel packages in Bali, Fiji, Vietnam and Thailand as well as a Nepal tour, a trip to China with China Bestours, a Nexus Holidays Canada/Alaska Cruise Tour and an 18-day Mediterranean trip with Med Experience.

The international packages offer tiered pricing based on whether a booking is last minute (for departure in the next two weeks or so) or in low, shoulder or high season.

After purchasing and paying for the deal, via credit card or PayPal, customers receive an emailed voucher which they then present to the supplier when finalising their booking.
