



VR Hotels Aus debut

NEW Zealand-based hotel group VR Hotels is set to make its debut in the Australian market, with the 87-room Wirrina Resort in South Australia soon to relaunch.

Wirrina Resort is located approx 70 minutes from Adelaide on the Fleurieu Peninsula, near to the state's McLaren Vale wine region.

VR Hotels, who operate 18 properties in the US, is spending \$1.5m on renovating 50 rooms at present and is also set to add a Kids Club and Beauty Spa.

Existing facilities include a pool, spa, tennis courts, gym and a conference centre with capacity for 500 guests theatre-style.

HWT flagship stores shut

HELLOWORLD this morning confirmed that it has closed its "store-in-store" operations inside the Australia Post offices in the Brisbane and Melbourne CBDs.

The closure was flagged in a Travel Compensation Fund update, which said that the Stella Travel Services Pty Ltd-owned businesses were being voluntarily withdrawn from the TCF.

The "travel superstore" initiative in partnership with Australia Post debuted in the Qld capital two and a half years ago (TD 29 Nov 2011), with former HWT md David Rivers at the time flagging a roll-out to other locations.

A second company-owned Harvey World Travel store opened some months later in the Australia Post headquarters at 111 Bourke Street in the central Melbourne CBD (TD 26 Mar 2012).

The move was part of a push into travel services by Australia Post which also included a foreign exchange pact with American Express, travel insurance sales and international SIM cards.

Australia Post has continued its focus on travel, with the organisation currently heavily promoting its offerings via national television campaigns.

But these won't include the 'store-in-store' concept, with Helloworld issuing a statement saying that "after thoroughly testing the performance of the instore concept, Australia Post and Harvey World Travel have agreed to conclude this trial."

The HWT Queen Street Brisbane outlet closed on 17 Apr, while **HWT Bourke Street ceased** operations on 30 Apr.

Helloworld said it was continuing to work with Australia Post "to investigate alternative opportunities to collaborate on travel related initiatives".

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JQ PER terminal rejig

JETSTAR has begun advising passengers of impending changes at Perth Airport which will see the low-cost carrier's domestic flights move from Terminal 4 to the nearby Terminal 3.

The relocation to T3 - the same hub used by Virgin Australia in Perth - takes effect from 03 Jun.

Perth Airport says the two terminals are within walking distance of each other.

JQ's international services will continue to operate from T1.



Tourism funding slashed?

THE Federal Government's National Commission of Audit has recommended wide-ranging cuts in support for tourism, including halving the funding for Tourism Australia as well as slashing tourism industry grants.

The changes are among a raft of proposals, with the report suggesting abolishing a large number of bodies and programs which assist Australian exporters.

Approximately \$185m in federal funding is directed towards tourism initiatives and management, the report says, with much of the money going to Tourism Australia.

However, other programs now administered by Austrade are also proposed for the chop, including the T-QUAL grants scheme and the Tourism Industry Regional Development Fund (TD 20 Nov) which supports investment in tourism-related accommodation, infrastructure and facilities.

"Nearly two thirds of Tourism Australia's budget is directed to advertising & other promotional activities," the report stated.

"While tourism is one of Australia's main exports, most of the benefits of tourism accrue to the tourism operators," the report says, adding: "There is no clear reason why significant funding should be provided to tourism above other Australian

export industries".

Accordingly, the Commission has proposed the cessation of grant funding for the tourism industry, while TA's funding would be reduced by 50% to focus on international marketing and the body incorporated into a "commercial arm of the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade".

The ceo of industry lobby group Tourism and Transport Forum, Ken Morrison, described the proposals as "a dumb idea" which would "dramatically impact business, local jobs and investment prospects for Australia.

"The reality is that international visitors spend \$80 million across Australia every single day...it is an industry which supports 900,000 jobs and 280,000 businesses".

Tourism Accommodation Australia has also called on the government to reject the Tourism Australia recommendations, with TAA md Rodger Powell saying "the accommodation sector is driven by marketing, and that's the chief function of Tourism Australia".

New VUSA committee

JANETTE Davie from Pinpoint Travel Group has been elected as the new president of the Visit USA Committee.

The move follows the shakeup at the organisation's annual general meeting earlier this year (TD 25 Feb) at which former president Geoffrey Hutton, who had headed Visit USA for over 20 years, was controversially not renominated to the committee.

The new office-bearers also include Tim Swan from Air NZ as Vice President; United Airlines' Chris Petty as Treasurer; and Juliette Myers of the Anaheim Orange County CVB as Secretary.

Other committee members are Peter Douglas of Excite Holidays, Visit California's Tristan Freedman, Ashlee Galea of Hawaii Tourism, Craig Gibbons from LA Tourism, House of Travel's Farid Hacene, Melanie Mayer of Las Vegas CVA, Maria Pantazis from Qantas, Sherilyn Robinson of Destination USA, Meredith Salotto from Nevada Commission on Tourism, Danielle Tuffield of Universal Parks and Resorts, HA's Hugh Twomey, and Paul Yankson of Virgin Australia.

TCF ceo flags \$250k exposure

AS MUCH as \$250,000 in consumer claims is expected in relation to Sydney-based Travelaccess, which was non-voluntarily terminated from participation in the Travel Compensation Fund this morning.

The TCF confirmed to *Travel Daily* that it has already started receiving claims connected to Blacktown, Sydney-based Allied-Summa Travel & Tours Pty Ltd which trades as Travelaccess (ABN: 86 002 764 212).

"It's a substantial one," TCF ceo Glen Wells told **TD**.

Travelaccess was founded in 1982 and focused on the travel needs of Filipino Australians in Sydney, formerly operating as Jetset Travel Fairfield.

The company also ran a wholesale operation called Allied Holidays which specialised in golf and sports packages to the Philippines, while its website promotes "cosmetic tourism"

to "Philippines - the Island of Wellness".

Despite the claims and the termination from the TCF, the company appears to be still trading, with its phone number still being answered and queries for flight bookings fulfilled this morning.

A booking engine on the travelaccess.com.au website is also still active and accepting bookings and payments.

No more QF vMPDs

QANTAS has advised that it will no longer accept vMPD as a form of payment on the Ticket Request and Name Correction forms for ticketing via the Qantas Industry Centre and Group Travel

The accepted form of payment for all Qantas ticketing is now EMD-S, however credit card payment will also be an option on the Name Correction form.

TripAdvisor purchase

TRIPADVISOR has announced the acquisition of Massachusetts-based Vacation Home Rentals, a website which offers an inventory of more than 14,000 properties around the world.

The operation will become part of the TripAdvisor Vacation Rentals group which also acquired Spanish vacations website Niumba 12 months ago.

North disqualified

JUSTIN North, the celebrity "culinary ambassador" for Accor's Pullman Hotels & Resorts, has been banned from running companies for two years by the Australian Securities and Investments Commission.

The move follows the spectacular collapse of North's restaurant group in 2012 which left creditors \$7m out of pocket.

The upmarket eateries included Becasse, which was located in the Westfield Sydney complex.



Window Seat

AIRLINES rank about the same as the tax man in terms of customer satisfaction, according to a new study released in the US earlier this week.

The American Customer Satisfaction Index travel report scored airlines with an average 69% rating - marginally ahead of the American Internal Revenue Service, reports *USA Today*.

Interestingly, the study also found that satisfaction scores for online travel agents in America increased slightly year-on-year, to 77%.

However "even though travel sites market themselves as one-stop shopping spots for travel, customers prefer booking rooms directly with hotel websites, and flights with airline sites," the report concluded.

Athena claims procedure

AGENTS with clients affected by the bankruptcy of Classic International Cruises are being invited to submit final claims to liquidators for consideration.

Classic International Cruises operated MV Athena until late in 2012 when the vessel was impounded in France due to nonpayment of bills (TD 31 Oct 2012).

Thousands of customers were impacted by the collapse, which at the time was said to amount to around \$4 million.

The Travel Compensation Fund has to date paid out \$3.1 million in claims to 1395 consumers.

In Dec 2012, accountants PKF Lawler were named Joint & Several Voluntary Administrators of Classic International Cruises.

A public notice which featured in Travel Daily this week from PKF indicates funds held on trust by the company are intended to be released for persons whose cruises had been booked and paid for the 2012/13 cruise season which were subsequently axed.

"The Liquidators will distribute the funds having regard only to the claims of which the

Liquidators have notice." the notification advises.

Claimants need to inform PKF Lawler in writing, "identifying the basis of their entitlements to the funds and the amount...to which they are entitled.

"All supporting documents should also be provided."

PKF Lawler said it would not be liable to any person whose claim the liquidators has not had notice of at the time of distribution.

TCF ceo Glen Wells told TD that the fund has already received \$1.5 million from around \$3m that was in the CIC trust account, but a judge has ruled that before final payment is made to the TCF, the administrators must make this final public appeal for any potential outstanding claims.

As well as the TD ad for claimants yesterday, PKF Lawler has also advertised in WA consumer newspapers.
