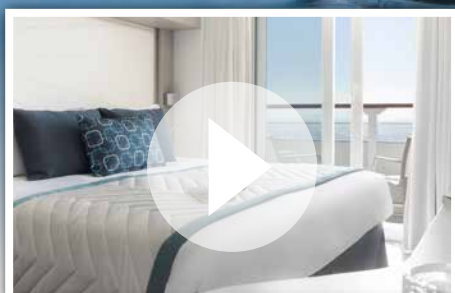

Australasia key for NCL

NORWEGIAN Cruise Line's new Australian office (**TD** 01 Jul) is part of major international expansion plans for the company, which will boost its capacity by 40% in the coming years.

Speaking to *Travel Daily* in Sydney yesterday on the first formal day of the local operation, Harry Sommer, executive vice president of NCL Holdings said Australia joins new offices in Brazil and Hong Kong, with further growth planned in Asia.

"North America has been a great market for us, but growth is slowing," he said.

The acquisition of Oceania Cruises and Regent Seven Seas Cruises has given Norwegian critical mass, with a combined 21 vessels across its three brands.

More are coming too, with *Norwegian Escape* to launch next month and the upcoming *Oceania Sirena* and *Regent Seven Seas Explorer* debuting in 2016.

Sommer said the company believed having a local call centre in the new Sydney office would be a significant advantage for agents selling all three brands,

providing support for existing partnerships representing Oceania and Regent Seven Seas.

He said Australia was already a top three market for the company, with the brands "resonating really well with the Australian consumer".

Sommer wouldn't be drawn on the expected growth in local business, but said moving from one employee in Australia and New Zealand to around 40 was an indication of the potential.

"Put it this way, if we were looking to grow 5% I wouldn't bother," he said.

NCL has already published its itineraries out to 2017 so there are no short-term plans to expand local deployments for the company which will bring *Norwegian Star* for a limited season cruising out of Sydney and Auckland in 2016/17.

But with further capacity under construction including two new "Breakaway-Plus" class ships for delivery in 2018 and 2019, "we will be assessing opportunities for the future," Sommer said.

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VA axe ALH, EPR, RVT

THREE destinations in Western Australia will disappear entirely from the Virgin Australia network effective 28 Feb next year.

Services to Albany, Esperance and Ravensthorpe were reduced in Dec last year (**TD** 03 Dec), however demand has now slipped to unsustainable levels.

The latest cuts take the number of regional destinations axed in WA to four after Busselton, which loses VA service from 22 Apr.

Virgin Australia has issued a commercial policy & waiver code of SWF21390913WA to remove change and cancellation fees for affected passengers.

Record global loads

AVERAGE load factors on air services globally reached a record 84.7% in Aug, according to the latest passenger data from IATA.

Total passenger demand for the month rose 7.1% year-on-year, while capacity in turn grew 5.9%.

Helloworld NZ agent exodus

MORE than thirty Helloworld affiliated agencies in New Zealand have resigned from the group in the wake of the company's move to establish the *helloworld* brand across the Tasman (**TD** Mon).

Earlier this week Helloworld CEO Elizabeth Gaines confirmed the acquisition of ten Air New Zealand Holidays offices across the country, with Air NZ exiting the retail operations which it now considers as non-core.

The move is expected to see the company rebrand its existing Harvey World Travel and United Travel franchisees as *helloworld* - a move which has been long resisted by the 45 or so United Travel members.

According to reports this morning, more than two thirds of the United Travel members have resigned, with rival group First Travel announcing that it will grow by 34 new agencies.

Helloworld NZ CEO Greg Leighton has confirmed the departures, saying "some franchisees have made the decision that our approach is not for them."

"While this is disappointing, we are confident that we will offer an extremely strong value proposition for our New Zealand branded and associate franchisees," he said.

United Travel, which is 50% owned by its members, voted earlier this year not to adopt the Helloworld brand (**TD** 06 Mar).

Leighton said the decision to establish *helloworld* had "resonated well with our Harvey World Travel franchisees".

He said the company would continue to work closely with members on a case-by-case basis ahead of the 2016 launch of *helloworld* in New Zealand "to achieve an optimal outcome for all".

SANZAR rugby pact

FLIGHT Centre entertainment and sports management travel brand Stage & Screen Travel Services has secured a five-year contract for int'l rugby union.

SANZAR, a joint venture made up of rugby union organisations in Argentina, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa, saw travel arrangements for players, officials and staff managed by Stage & Screen, starting from yesterday.

The contract for Stage & Screen covers international test matches as well as the Super Rugby comp.

Stage & Screen general manager Tiziano Galipo said the company was skilled in managing complex travel logistics with multinational itineraries and excess baggage.

"Under our service model, each team across SANZAR's key regions will have a dedicated Stage and Screen travel manager. This will ensure team managers & players have a single point of contact for all of their travel needs," he said.

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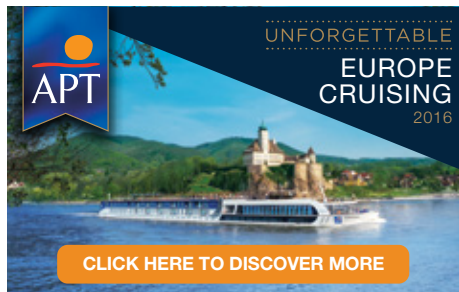
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Hotel hurdles hit tourism

A PLETHORA of planning regulations are causing significant delays and uncertainty for hotel developments which are "vital to Australia's surging tourism sector," according to a report released today by Trade Minister Andrew Robb and new Tourism Minister Richard Colbeck.

The Urbis report on *Hotel Development Regulations in Australia*, commissioned by Austrade, identifies opportunities to improve planning and environmental approval processes across the country.

The report recommends that federal, state, territory and local governments work together to promote "simplicity, transparency and predictability" in all jurisdictions, with Robb saying new properties are required to boost the quality and supply of hotel rooms.

He said there was a healthy

pipeline of hotel investment opportunities, particularly in capital cities.

"Now it is time for us to deliver on that pipeline," he said.

Colbeck said too often new hotel developments are slowed by unnecessary red tape.

"Working across all levels of government to make our regulatory environment more investment-friendly will have broader benefits outside tourism," he said.

Another recommendation urges stronger coordination between different levels of government, adopting a flexible approach to design requirements, making 'fast tracked' development approval processes available for low risk projects, and putting more emphasis on pre-approval engagement and case management - to view the report, see www.austrade.gov.au.

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JQ, LAN flag c'share growth

FURTHER details of the new codeshare arrangement between Jetstar and LATAM Airlines (**TD** 21 Sep) have been revealed, with the Latin American carrier to place its code on 15 JQ-operated flights.

Effective 25 Oct, the initial arrangement will see Jetstar carry LAN Airlines' designator code on Trans-Tasman routes ex Auckland to Melbourne & the Gold Coast.

Also from Auckland, the new codeshare will cover domestic routes to Christchurch, Dunedin, Queenstown and Wellington.

In Australia, LAN will place its code on Jetstar metal to Byron

Bay, Cairns, Darwin, Gold Coast, Hamilton Island, Maroochydore and Hobart, ex Sydney.

LAN Airlines said in a statement: "In the future, the airline expects to strengthen the alliance by incorporating international routes between countries in Oceania and South America."

LATAM Airlines Grp vp strategic alliances Soledad Berrios said the new deal strengthens the existing relationship with Jetstar.

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Plenty to do in Britain in 2016

With the 2015 Rugby World Cup underway, packaged sales for the tournament sold through Australian sellers (Flight Centre, Gulliver Sport Travel, Qantas Holidays and Sportsnet Holidays) reached the 15,000 mark - on par with expectations from the local tourism board, VisitBritain.

"Expectations were there would be an additional 30,000 Australian visitors into the UK, and by all accounts the [Rugby World Cup] packages have sold really well," insights & communications mgr Australia Kristen Angus told **TD**.

While exact market attendances may be hard to gauge for the RWC, Angus said Britain as a whole is set to prosper once again from another major sporting event in the years to come.

"Hallmark events such as the Olympics have done so much for Britain in terms of driving our welcome message.

"I think we are the only nation to successfully build on tourism after an Olympics where we had two years growth out of Australia."

Angus said Britain's next major sports event would be the 2019

Cricket World Cup, which would likely see a spike in arrivals out of the subcontinent and Australia.

Next year, Britain is celebrating the Year of Gardens in London for Lancelot 'Capability' Brown who revolutionised landscape design in the UK 300 years ago.

VisitBritain marketing manager Mark Haynes told **Travel Daily** gardens are a massive touch point for Australians, with some 60% of Aussies visiting a garden or park while in the United Kingdom.

Iconic garden sites incl Blenheim Palace in Oxfordshire (which will also appear in the soon-to-be-released 007 film, *Spectre*) and Chatsworth House in Derbyshire.

The birth dates of many 'Literary Legends' will also form a focal point of celebrations next year, with events in the Lakes District to mark the 150th birthday of Beatrix Potter and in Wales for the 100th birthday of Roald Dahl.

Other literary milestones incl Charlotte Bronte's 200th birthday and 400 years since the death of William Shakespeare.

Echo Entertainment

TOURISM has every ability to fill the economic gap left by the mining downturn, according to Echo Entertainment ceo Matt Bekier, but only if infrastructure & services are significantly improved.

Speaking at an American Chamber of Commerce function in Sydney this week, Bekier said better signage for Chinese tourists also need a wider rollout.

"We're number one in terms of where they want to go, but we're only number 15 in terms of where they actually go," he said.

"This is going to be the next mining boom," Bekier added.

Echo Entertainment was chosen as the preferred proponent to develop a casino & integrated resort complex at the Queen's Wharf in Brisbane (**TD** 21 Jul), with building to begin in 2017.

Bekier said tourism was now in an "arms race" of sorts, with cities around the world competing for the attention and spend of global travel markets such as China.

Amtrak baggage levy

PASSENGERS boarding Amtrak trains in North America with more than two carry-on bags and two personal items will now be hit with a \$20 fine for each extra.

Overweight bags owners will be slugged also if carry-on bags weigh more than 50lbs (22.6kgs) or if personal items tip the scales at more than 25lbs (11.3kgs).

Venezuela warning

ESCALATING tensions on the border between Venezuela and Colombia in South America have led DFAT to issue a warning to any Australia travellers in the area.

Venezuela has closed its land border to Colombia indefinitely, with DFAT urging Aussies not to consider trying to cross by land.

TOURISM Philippines has launched an online travel agent training course aimed at making the destination easier to sell.

The Philippines Specialist Program will consist of a series of modules able to be completed at leisure, with graduates to be given priority access to fam trips & furnished with new sales leads.

Orlando face scans

AUTOMATED facial recognition technology will be employed to scan arriving passengers in the US as part of new requirements from US Customs & Border Protection.

Airport tech giant SITA will drive the rollout, to begin at Orlando Airport before being rolled out to other international gateways.

A FIVE-PRONGED strategy to build a sustainable global tourism market has this week been outlined by Tourism Noosa as it seeks to grow its global brand.

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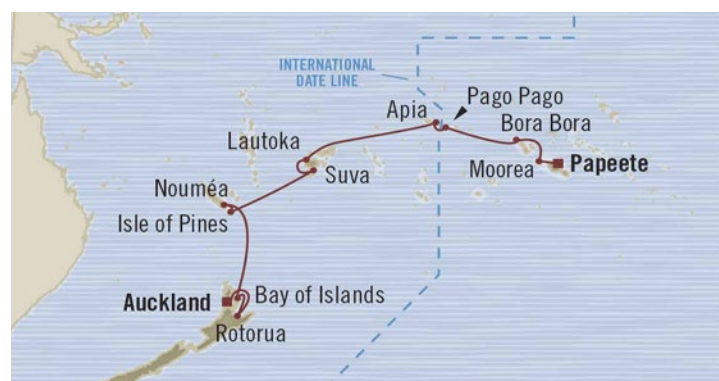
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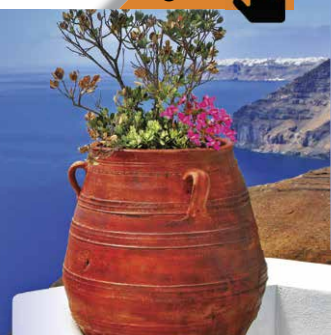
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
