Greenbury, who established the company in 2001 and sold it to AccomCorp in 2005, says he wasn't involved in the financial administration of the firm.

With the relaunch under his new business Travel Directions Pty Ltd he has been assisting clients with existing bookings to minimise fallout from the AccomCorp closure.

That has included facilitating credit card charge-backs and writing letters of demand to the administrator, while deal suppliers Groupon and Our Deal have also provided significant assistance, Greenbury said.

He said there is enough money in the trust account to resolve all customer issues but the administrators Ernst & Young are not providing refunds at this time. "We are fighting that situation

and we have every chance of

success." Greenbury said. The new business of Australian **Escapes Holiday & Travel** Club commenced trading today and will honour all promotional vouchers & existing memberships, with Greenbury promising to "open up many more resort and travel options... at even better prices".

"The new team is building a more efficient business," the firm says online, adding "you will be rewarded with bigger holiday savings, lower membership fees and better service".

Mayo lobbies state governments

TRAVELMANAGERS chairman Barry Mayo has highlighted mainstream media coverage around the closure of Gold Coastbased Australian Escapes (TD Thu), as raising concerns about a possible decline in consumer confidence in travel agents.

In a statement issued this morning Mayo is questioning the various state governments about their views in light of the "increasing number of travel agency collapses and resulting consumer losses after having abandoned the Travel Compensation Fund".

He said the governments are guilty of disbanding the TCF without ensuring the travelling public was provided with an effective form of consumer protection against travel agent insolvency.

Mayo said it was good news Australian Escapes is back in business (see p1) as none of its 16,000 members, 40 employees and other creditors have been adversely impacted, "however this doesn't negate or reverse the negative publicity".

FLIGHT Centre this morning confirmed that its corporate brands have partnered with limousine operator Get Picked Up Australia to offer a new ride sharing service "to rival Uber". Dubbed GPU Ride, the service

will be trialled in NSW with the FCM Travel Solutions and Corporate Traveller brands, with availability to expand into other states and territories shortly.

FCM gm for Australia James Kavanagh predicted the product would be appealing to business travellers who wanted the reliability of a door-to-door transfer service that can be booked in advance.

"With Uber services, they can only be booked the moment you are ready to travel...with GPU Ride you make the booking in advance which is convenient for early morning flights and offers peace of mind that your ride will be ready for you when you need to leave," Kavanagh said.

Pricing is comparable to taxi fares and other ridesharing services, he said, with a special offer including flat fares of \$35

between the Sydney CBD to both the domestic and international airport terminals.

"Customers of Flight Centre's corporate brands will enjoy the convenience of being able to book their GPU Ride through their corporate travel consultant at the same time they book their air and hotel," Kavanagh added.

He said the system would roll out into other jurisdictions when legislation for ridesharing allows services to operate legally in those states.

Another Starwood bid

CHINESE group Anbang has again upped its offer for Starwood, which has determined the revised deal is likely to lead to a 'superior proposal' as defined in Starwood's merger agreement with Marriott.

Anbang is now offering US\$82.75 per Starwood share, an increase of US\$4.75 on the prior proposal which was trumped by Marriott last week (TD Wed).

At this stage the Starwood board is continuing to support the Marriott offer.

EK offers 48-hour check-in

EMIRATES has doubled its online check-in window to 48 hours, saying the move offers passengers greater flexibility in seat selection as well as reducing waiting times at the airport.

The move is effective immediately for all EK flights globally, but for flights to and from the USA while check-in is available 48 hours before departure, boarding passes will be issued 24 hours in advance.

"We have always taken into account feedback to improve the customer journey and the extension of online check-in is a result of that," said EK senior vice president of corporate communications, Alex Knigge.

The earlier check-in window will also mean better availability of upgrades for members of the Skywards loyalty program, and offers the potential for improved communication with customers in the event of disruptions. As well as online check-in, EK offers 24-hour carpark check-in facilities at its Dubai hub, with passengers able to drop bags from 24 hours to six hours prior to departure to ease crowds during peak travel periods.

BEST Western Hotels & Resorts has signed a new master franchise agreement with Delhibased Sorrel Hospitality which will see the firm responsible for driving the Best Western portfolio in India, Sri Lanka & Bangladesh.

AA to share profits

AMERICAN Airlines has announced a new profit-sharing scheme under which it will distribute 5% of its pre-tax earnings with all employees.

The new arrangements, which do not include top management, will come into force early next year, based on the carrier's 2016 financial results.

AA has more than 115,000 staff across the globe, and based on last year's whopping US\$6.3 billion figure it would have paid out about US\$315 million.

The move sees American mirror similar initiatives in place at rival carriers including United, Delta and Southwest.

Virgin Australia had initially axed its regular services to Port Vila up until 01 Apr (*TD* 05 Feb), having shelved flights to the Vanuatu capital in late Jan due to rising concerns of the state of the runway at VLI.

The memo states: "All Virgin Australia services will be cancelled until Monday 21 May inclusive. Please note, updates will be advised about services beyond this date when Vanuatu authorities release further information."

The Aussie airline has issued a waiver code of SWF28040112VLI which can be used by agents who have guests directly affected by the cancellation of services.

It can be used on tickets issued on or before 16 Mar, for departures from 30 Jan-21 May inclusive, Virgin Australia said.

The waiver code is valid until 14 Jun.

MEANWHILE, Air Vanuatu continues to operate regular services to VLI and is adding an extra flight from Sydney every Sat starting 04 Jun.

Barnett takes tourism

WESTERN Australian Premier Colin Barnett will be responsible for the state's Tourism portfolio following a cabinet reshuffle according to a report this morning in The West Australian.

The move sees Barnett stand down from his State Development portfolio to take over from former tourism minister Kim Hames.

This makes Barnett the first Premier in two decades to be handling tourism.

The West Australian is predicting tourism will come to the fore in the state with Barnett expected to highlight major investments in Elizabeth Quay, the City Link and Perth Stadium as he runs for re-election.

From AFTA's chief executive, Jayson Westbury

From my own experience it would seem that everyone in the country took a domestic holiday as the airport seemed much busier than usual.

Bali 30 day visa-free

THE Indonesian Government has finally come through and scrapped the US\$35 fee for Australian travellers, introducing a 30-day visa-free short visit.
