Hogan, Rigney leaving EY

TWO of Etihad's most senior executives. Aussies James Hogan and James Rigney, will leave the carrier later this year (TD breaking news) as its board continues an "ongoing, companywide strategic review".

Hogan became ceo of Etihad in 2006, moving to the Abu Dhabibased UAE flag carrier after four years heading up Gulf Air.

More recently the rapidly growing airline restructured to become the Etihad Aviation Group, of which Hogan is now president and ceo - overseeing businesses incl Etihad Airways, Hala, Etihad Airport Services and Etihad Airways Partners.

"We are very grateful to James," said chairman H.E. Mohamed Mubarak Fadhel Al Mazrouei.

"In just ten years, he has overseen the growth of the company from a 22-plane regional carrier into a 120 aircraft global airline and aviation group, with seven airline equity partnerships which together serve more than 120 million guests every year." Hogan and Rigney will join a

after they leave Etihad in the second half of 2017, with a global search for a new group ceo and cfo already under way.

Hogan's imminent departure was rumoured last month, with a German news outlet citing issues around Etihad's European alliances (TD 21 Dec 2016).

Mazrouei said key priorities for the business going forward included ensuring the airline is the "right size and the right shape...we must progress and adjust our airline equity partnerships even as we remain committed to the strategy".

Etihad's equity partnerships include a significant investment in Virgin Australia, along with Alitalia, Air Seychelles, airberlin, Etihad Regional and Jet Airways.

Hogan said he, along with the board and 26,000 Etihad staff, were proud of the company's substantial contribution to the United Arab Emirates and to the development of Abu Dhabi.

"The last decade has seen incredible results but this only represents a first chapter in the story of Etihad," he said.



South Africa air hitch

NEW regulations expected to pass soon in South Africa could put companies flying to lodge destinations out of business, a local carrier has warned.

Federal Airlines spokesman Eugene Mostert told South African media three-quarters of companies flying to airstrips would shut down a year after implementation.

The regulation would require all airstrips to be licensed and firefighter compliant.

This would be at the expense of the lodge owners, who own or lease the airstrips.

AN OUTBREAK of dengue fever has been declared by health authorities in Vanuatu after a surge in suspected cases over Dec and Jan.

The Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade has updated its travel warning and highlighted advice on protection against mosquito bites.

On-time rate slips

ON-TIME arrival figures for Australia's domestic airlines slipped during Dec, falling below the long-term average.

Figures from the Bureau of Infrastructure, Transport and Regional Economics (BITRE) show on-time performance across all carriers was 80% for arrivals and 81% for departures, a decline on the average of 82.7% for arrivals and 84.2% for departures.

Qantas achieved the best on-time arrival figure of 83.5% during Dec, followed by Virgin at 83.1%, Tigerair Australia at 73.7% and Jetstar's 69.0%.



Kenya airport plan?

KENYA'S government is reportedly seeking a \$368m loan from the World Bank to upgrade the country's airports.

The project would include improving the capacity of the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) from 7.5 million passengers a year to 20 million.

In 2013 a fire gutted the airport and last year a \$650m plan to add a new passenger terminal at JKIA was axed (*TD* 31 Mar).

The govt put the cancellation down to financial pressures and the capacity of the airport already increasing due to upgrades.

OZ lures CNY visitors

AN ESTIMATED 81,000

additional Chinese visitors will make their way to Australian shores this Chinese New Year, representing a total of \$1.6 billion in expenditure for Jan.

Tourism and Transport Forum (TTF) ceo Margy Osmond called the Lunar New Year period an "absolute gold mine" for the country's visitor economy.

"By our estimate, Chinese New Year will help to deliver a record-breaking 195,000 monthly visitors from China – a great start for 2017, and keeping China on course to become our biggest international visitor market (overtaking New Zealand) by the middle of this year," she said.

Chinese visitors spend an average of \$8,328 per trip - the highest spending of all nationalities.

TOURISM New Zealand wants to make it known that Kaikoura, the region struck by a 7.8m earthquake last Nov, is safe and open for business.

"Understandably there has been a drop off in travel to Kaikoura in the wake of the earthquake," said Tourism New Zealand director trade, PR and major events Rene de Monchy.

"As access improves, more tourists are arriving but it will take some time to get back to the way it was."

Those travelling to Cuba for tourist purposes only will not be eligible for travel on US airlines.
