First with the news

The Australian division, currently involving 140 homebased Travel Counsellors, was earmarked for growth between 250-300, including an additional 50-60 new recruits this year.

"We expect a disproportionate amount of our global growth to come from Australia," Byrne said.

"So if Australia is 8% of our numbers at the moment and we're going to double our numbers globally, we don't expect to just double our numbers here - we'd expect to do more growth proportionally in Australia than the other markets."

Having recently expanded its Melbourne regional HQ, the UK-based group has embarked on a three-pronged strategy it calls RR<sup>2</sup>P, focussed on Recruitment, Referrals & Rebookings, and the expansion of its in-house technology platform Phenix. See more on page four.

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## New China-Australia flts

**XIAMEN** Airlines (MF) is adding another route to Australia with the carrier filing to begin new Boeing 787 *Dreamliner* services between Xiamen and Melbourne, via Hangzhou starting Dec.

In an application to the China Civil Aviation Authority (CAAC) last week, Xiamen Airlines said it intended to introduce the new roundtrip service on a thrice weekly basis, using a mix of 787-8 or 787-9 *Dreamliners*.

The Chinese carrier launched direct services from Xiamen to Melbourne in Jul last year, initially as twice weekly before increasing to thrice in early Dec (*TD* 25 Aug). MF's Melbourne operation follows the launch of services to Sydney in late 2015.

MEANWHILE, in a separate application to the CAAC filed late last month, Hainan Airlines has sought approval for new flights between Shenzhen and Cairns.

Hainan Airlines' Cairns service is slated to commence in Jan 2018, operate three times weekly and use a combination of Boeing 787 *Dreamliners* and Airbus A330s.

HU is owned by Chinese giant HNA Aviation Group, and is one of a number of airlines that Virgin Australia is seeking a reciprocal codeshare agreement with on flights between Australia & China.

It's likely the Cairns service would come under the umbrella Alliance Framework Agreement between VA & HNA, which last week gained a favourable draft determination for five years from the ACCC (*TD* Fri).

## oneworld chairman

**FINNAIR** chief executive Pekka Vauramo has been named as the chairman of global airline alliance **one**world for a two-year term, replacing Cathay Pacific Airways' former ceo Ivan Chu.

The role will see Vauramo oversee the alliance's governance and work closely with **one**world chief executive officer (& former Helloworld boss), Rob Gurney.

Vauramo has been Finnair's chief exec officer since 2013.



#### New name for HNL

**HONOLULU** Int'l Airport has been renamed Daniel K. Inouye Int'l Airport in recognition of the state's late senior senator.

The name change coincides with a massive modernisation project. The airport's three letter designation code remains HNL.

## TC scores 10 for Aus at the MCG



**TRAVEL** Counsellors marked its 10th Australian conference at the weekend, using the Melbourne Cricket Ground as the stage for an upbeat message to its local team.

The group's ceo Steve Byrne said the Australian operations had recorded a turnover of \$8 million when launched in 2008.

Since then, it had grown to a turnover of just under \$60 million, with the Australian branch forecast to deliver growth at a higher rate than other markets over coming years.

Byrne said much had changed at Travel Counsellors since an investment by private equity firm Equistone over two years ago.

"We've professionalised the business, we made it more corporate some might say, and it has more structure," Byrne said

"In the course of those two and

a half years we've doubled the size of the company and trebled the value of it," he said.

Byrnes highlighted several factors indicating Australia would out-strip growth in other markets over coming years, including its propensity to travel, longer travel habits, higher booking values and a taste for tailor-made travel.

Other positives included the booming cruise market, a comparatively sound economy, lower levels of online penetration and a large pool of experienced, entrepreneurial travel agents.

"It's got all the ingredients to say we should be, and will be, doing much better," Byrne said.


