

May departures up 5.5%

OUTBOUND travel from Australia continues on an upward trajectory, with May figures from the Australian Bureau of Statistics indicating a 5.5% year-on-year trend estimate increase in "resident returns".

The report released today showed 822,200 short-term travellers returning to Australia during the month, with Japan the strongest-growing destination, up a whopping 20.9% year-on-year.

There was also double-digit growth in travel to China, up 16.3%, Indonesia which rose 11% and India which increased 10.9%.

Travel declined 2.3% to New Zealand, and 3.2% to Thailand, while the only other top 10 destination to see a drop was Fiji, down 0.4% versus May 2017.

Inbound tourism is also growing, with short-term visitor arrivals

currently 3.7% higher than 12 months ago.

The fastest growing markets for Australian visitation were India, up 20.9%, followed by Hong Kong (7.6%) and China (6.9%).

There were declines in arrivals from Malavsia, down 13%, as well as the USA which dropped 4.5% and Singapore, down 4.4%.

Overall there were 609,300 short-term visitor arrivals into Australia during May, with the top source being NZ with 107,500 followed by China at 89,500 and then the USA with 48,300.


The acquisition takes the number of WETG's brands to 13 and adds a base near Sydney, complementing existing operations in Alice Springs, Darwin and Launceston.

Airlines clash over pilots

MAJOR carriers have defended their recruitment processes after an angry attack by Regional Express (Rex), which has blamed "pilot poaching" for its crew shortages and service disruptions.

The regional carrier issued an open letter on Fri accusing Qantas and Virgin Australia of "rapacious plundering" of its pilot pool, saying the major carriers had taken 17% of its first officers and 56% of its captains in two years.

"These two airlines are causing widespread chaos and disruptions to regional air travel by their selfish and irresponsible actions," Rex said.

"Because of the critical pilot shortage, Rex is not able to have its usual contingent of stand-by pilots rostered for duty."

Rex said its Australian Airline Pilot Academy had trained over 220 cadets in the past decade, and said the major carriers were not utilising their resources to train their own pilots.

Qld travel incubator

AMADEUS is sponsoring Queensland's "Horizons" tourism industry accelerator, which aims to develop the state into the "world's global hub for innovation in travel and tourism".

The 12-week program starts on 24 Sep with cohorts in Cairns and Brisbane, working with local and regional startups who will receive training, mentors, access to co-working space and \$30,000 of seed investment.

the accusations saying "It's strange for a company to blame its competitor for its employee retention problems".

"It's natural to see some movement between airlines from people seeking advancement, just like in every other industry," the spokesperson said.

"No Australian airline invests more in training pilots than the Qantas Group."

Earlier this year Qantas announced the establishment of a pilot academy able to train up to 500 pilots a year (**TD** 22 Feb).

A Virgin Australia spokesperson said the airline "strongly rejects any suggestions of impacting regional air service through our pilot recruitment".

"We have a comprehensive pilot recruitment and training process which includes running our own Virgin Australia Cadetship program in partnership with Flight Training Adelaide and working with a number of Australian universities to provide input into their pilot training," the spokesperson said.

"We're proud to offer a strong career path and development program, with almost 80% of current pilots having been with us for more than five years."

Air China cuts BNE

AIR China will suspend its flights between Beijing and Brisbane from next month, with GDS indicating the route will cease operating effective 23 Aug.

The suspension will continue through until early 2019, with a planned resumption from 02 Jan with thrice weekly A330 services.

Cathay-Brussels link

CATHAY Pacific will introduce codeshare services with Brussels Airlines from 26 Jul, placing its CX code on a series of intra-European routes from Belgium.

The arrangement involves SN flights from Brussels to Berlin Tegel, Hamburg, Lyon, Marseille, Toulouse, Oslo and Prague.

Tickets are now on sale and can be booked in conjunction with Cathay's four weekly flights between Hong Kong and Brussels.

VA short-haul boost

VIRGIN Australia will add more than 65 return services to its international short-haul network this summer, involving extra flights on South Pacific and New Zealand routes

The new services are on sale now and will operate between 28 Oct and 24 Mar.

The Sydney-Queenstown schedule will increase by 18 return services including 10 Sat flights and eight Sun services.

Melbourne-Queenstown flights also increase by 18, including 14 Sun flights and four Sat services, while the Brisbane-Christchurch schedule has an extra nine flights over the Christmas-New Year period, including new Fri night and Sun afternoon flights.

Sydney-Apia flights increase to three services per week between 28 Oct and 21 Jan

The Brisbane-Port Vila schedule will increase by 10 return services between 28 Oct and 11 Jan, including new Fri and Sun flights.

Overseas travel intentions up

population growth over the last decade has seen the number of Australians planning overseas trips almost double, according to a new Roy Morgan Research report.

The study says more than 2.3 million Australians - or 11.4% of the population - are currently intending to go abroad

The corresponding figure in 2008 was 1.2 million - or 7.2% of the population at the time.

According to Roy Morgan, there is also an increasing proportion of Australians planning to travel to Asia, with 5.1% of the population, or more than one million people, expecting to make Asia trips.

Australians were planning to travel to Asia.

The actual mix of destinations within Asia has also changed significantly, with travellers citing Indonesia (Bali) and Japan as their most likely travel choices.

By contrast, there has been a strong decline in travel intention to China over the same period.

In 2008 almost 10% of Australians planning an overseas trip in the next year were planning to visit China - compared to just 5.3% this year.

However Roy Morgan also noted that in 2008 Beijing hosted the Summer Olympics, which could have contributed to stronger interest a decade ago.

Intention to travel to Hong Kong had also fallen significantly, while other Asian destinations seeing a decline in popularity include Thailand, Vietnam and Malaysia, according to the study.

Versus 2008, holiday intention has increased for other countries in Asia including the Philippines, South Korea and India.

SHOCK horror - all those lovely Instagram photos of delightful holidays might not be real!

A new report from Allianz Global Assistance has found 36% of Millennials have "aimed to deceive their followers by posting social media vacation images that make trips look better than they are".

Key motivations included making friends & family jealous (65%) or competing with the holiday snaps of others (51%).

Those aged 18-34 were most likely to participate in social media deception, versus 15% of Gen Xers (aged 35-54) and just 5% of Baby Boomers (55+).

Facebook was cited as the most inspirational platform, followed by Instagram, Pinterest, Twitter and Snapchat.

CHINESE online travel giant Ctrip renewed its annual strategic cooperation agreement with Tourism New Zealand at an MoU signing in Shanghai last month.

Under the deal, the two sides will focus on NZ customised travel product development, especially for independent travellers.

Ctrip looks to further deepen its presence in the New Zealand market to provide one-stop integrated marketing solutions for Chinese travellers.

FR buys stake in OE

RYANAIR'S (FR) proposed acquisition of a 75% interest in the Austrian airline Laudamotion (OE) has been granted European Union approval.

The Irish airline already owns a 24.9% stake in OE and claims the re-entry of the Austrian carrier will offer greater competition and lower prices in Austria, Germany and Spain.

Japan rain delays

TORRENTIAL rain in the western regions of Japan has led to the disruption of a range of transportation services.

Temporary buses are available between Hiroshima Airport and Higashi Hiroshima station until normal operations resume.

Cancellations, delays and suspensions have impacted select train routes in the Chugoku and Shikoku areas, and closures are in place on the Sanyo, Chugoku, Kochi, Kyushu, and Higashi Kyushu Expressways.



The development involves the demolition of existing buildings and the creation of new facilities including elevated park space (TD 20 Dec 2016).

After a public consultation period, new plans involve relocating a proposed highrise office tower, pictured, and consolidating public space at the north of the site.

The development is alongside the existing Hyatt Regency Sydney and the site of the W Sydney due to open in 2020.


E-cig investigation

The Irish carrier was issued with a formal notice of the incident inquiry today.

Frankfurt police confirmed 33 passengers were taken to hospital complaining of headaches, earaches and nausea following the emergency landing.

The company has two weeks to show cause against a suspension.

STB said it "takes a serious view against errant travel agents and will not hesitate to take necessary actions to protect the reputation of Singapore's travel industry".
