Bali comp heats up

INDONESIA AirAsia will introduce direct daily Melbourne to Bali services on 20 Mar 2026.

The Asian airline said that joining the competitive route already operated by carriers such as Qantas and VA would strengthen its presence in Australia and unlock more gateways to Asia for travellers.

Other hubs in Indonesia AirAsia's network include Jakarta, Surabaya, Lombok, and Labuan.

To mark the launch, promotional fares from Melbourne to Bali start at \$199 one way, and fly-thru fares to Singapore via Bali lead in from \$296 one way.

Tauck axes local office

TAUCK'S Managing Director Australia David Clark is set to depart the business as the company winds down its Australian sales and reservations presence (**TD** breaking news).

As part of a review of its global operations, Tauck made the call to pull the pin on its Aussie office, with sales and reservations staff to exit their roles via a phased approach starting next year.

Sales roles will be maintained through to 31 Mar 2026, while the US-based operator's local reservations staff will be kept in place until 15 Dec 2026.

Tauck said it will continue to serve Australian travel advisors through its global sales and reservations teams, adding it would have dedicated teams in place to ensure a seamless transition and maintain its strong local trade relationships.

Outgoing Managing Director Clark (**pictured**) said it had been an honour to work with Tauck over the past six years.

"During this time, my team and I have been able to bring this wonderful, historic travel brand to our Australian travel partners and travellers, which has been



incredibly rewarding," he said.

The decision follows a renewed push by Tauck to target advisors in Australia, recently enhancing its rewards program (**TD** 08 Oct), and launching its biggest advisor incentive in Jan (**TD** 10 Jan). **AB**

McAlpine joins MSC

FORMER local Cunard chief Katrina McAlpine has been appointed by MSC Group to manage its MSC Cruises and Explora Journeys brands in Australia and New Zealand (**CW** breaking news).

Based in the company's Sydney office, McAlpine will start her new role on 12 Jan 2026 and report to senior executives across both brands, Antonio Paradiso and Francesco Iannaccone.

MSC Group began recruiting for a new local leader in Aug after the most senior local executive, Nicole Costantin, reverted back to managing sales solely for Explora Journeys shortly after assuming responsibility for both brands in Feb (**TD** 11 Aug).

"This appointment reinforces our growing presence in the region and showcases our determination to continue delivering on the goals and commitments we've established for this important market," Paradiso said.

McAlpine was most recently the Director of B2B Sales at Imagine Cruising, a role she started four months ago (**TD** 25 Aug).

NDC will be a baseline

NEXT year will see the global travel sector “say goodbye” to the idea of NDC being a standalone channel and instead become a baseline expectation for modern airline retailing, a new report from Sabre has predicted.

The tech company believes 2026 will be the watershed year of adoption because NDC has finally caught up with travel agency demands, namely breadth of content, depth of capabilities, and the ability to run efficient, end-to-end workflows.

“Over the past year, the industry has made substantial progress on all three areas,” the report said.

ATIA renewal opens

THE Australian Travel Industry Association (ATIA) has opened its Accreditation Renewal Portal for the 2026 accreditation year, giving businesses the opportunity to complete their renewal early.

While accredited entities will remain so until 31 Mar 2026, completing the renewal process early helps reduce administrative workload during peak trading periods, as well as enabling businesses to maintain up-to-date compliance information.

To complete the 2026 renewal, members will be asked to provide FY25 externally prepared financial statements (Profit & Loss and Balance Sheet) and current insurance certificates.

“Our goal is to make the process as accessible as possible for members while maintaining the checks and balances that ensure only the highest-quality operators remain accredited,” ATIA CEO Dean Long said.



Sabre added that the era of separate workflows, bespoke servicing processes and fragmented integrations is finally giving way to a connected approach to selling travel.

“Offer and order concepts are moving rapidly from vision to possibility to practice, enabling carriers to think beyond distribution and towards more holistic offer management.”

Sabre contended another key evolution of NDC has been the rise of NDC-IT as a bridging tech for airlines to offer richer, optimised, real-time offers to third parties, even before they fully transition their systems. *AB*

VA returns DRW-SYD

TICKETS have gone on sale for Virgin Australia’s relaunched Sydney to Darwin flights, which will take off on 22 Jun 2026.

The airline will operate the seasonal service four times a week during off-peak periods and up to daily during more popular demand times.

When the service launches next year, Virgin Australia will compete with both Qantas and Jetstar on the Top End route.

“Territorians have been asking for more aviation routes and affordable options, so we are delighted by today’s announcement,” NT Minister for Trade, Business and Asian Relations, Robyn Cahill, said.

Services will pause on 10 Jan 2027 and restart in Mar 2027.

Chilean resort delayed

SILVERSEA Cruises’ bold bid to build its own remote hotel in Chile has struck trouble, with its opening date delayed from early next year to Oct 2026.

The elegant Cormorant at 55 South located in the town of Puerto Williams will service Antarctica cruise guests who book Silversea fly-cruise packages.

However, the opening date has been pushed back by at least 10 months because of the need to “ensure every detail meets Silversea standards.”

No other details were disclosed around what has caused the delay - find out resort details [HERE](#).

Pearl finds Golding

EXPEDITION cruise start-up Pearl Expeditions has snapped up the services of Julie Golding only a month after being made redundant at Ponant.

In the role of Head of Commercial and Product Marketing, Golding will report to Pearl Expeditions General Manager Mick Fogg, and be charged with driving market share through new integrated sales and marketing strategies.

Pearl Expeditions Chair Sarina Bratton said Golding will be key to building on the commercial strength already created by partnership managers Nicci Foulsham and Jo Schuetz.

“Julie will ensure the unique experiences that have been expertly crafted by Pearl Expeditions are well articulated to our partners and consumer audiences, and this appointment marks our transition from start-up to a fully operational business model,” Bratton said.

APT early release

APT has unveiled a preview of its 2027 Australia program, featuring itineraries to the Kimberley and the outback in response to continued demand.

Highlights include a 10-day cruise on the ultra-luxury *Seabourn Pursuit*, small group outback touring, experiences such as scenic helicopter flights over the tip of Australia, sunset drinks with views of the Bungle Bungles and Zodiac exploration of Montgomery Reef.

Airline bounce-back

GLOBAL airline profitability is expected to stabilise in 2026, with the latest financial outlook from the International Air Transport Association (IATA) showing carriers are on track to achieve a combined total net profit of US\$41 billion in 2026.

The figure is up from US\$39.5 billion in 2025, and if reached, would set a new record.

However, the net profit margin is expected to be unchanged from 2025 at 3.9%, while the net profit per passenger transported is expected to be US\$7.90 (below the 2023 high of US\$8.50, and unchanged from 2025).

Total industry revenues are expected to reach US\$1.053 trillion in 2026 - an increase of 4.5% on the US\$1 trillion expected revenues in 2025.

Additionally, passenger numbers are forecast to hit 5.2 billion in 2026 - up 4.4% on 2025 - while load factors are likely to continue to set record highs.

Berlin set to experience Four Seasons for the first time in 20 years

walking distance.
