EK profits grow

EMIRATES has held onto its position as the world's most profitable airline, with its halfyear financial results for 2025/26 recording a AED\$12.2 billion (A\$5.1 billion) profit before tax.

The figure represents a 17% increase from the same period last year, making this the fourth consecutive year of record profitability for the half-year reporting period.

After accounting for income tax charges, the group's profit after tax is AED10.6 billion (A\$4.5 billion), up 13% from last year.

Additionally, Emirates maintained a strong EBITDA of AED21.1 billion (A\$8.9 billion), 3% higher than the same period last year.

QF's new cabin option

QANTAS has unveiled its new economy plus cabin, offering 40% more legroom, priority boarding, and priority access to overhead baggage space.

This new product (pictured) will be available from Feb 2026 on the Airbus A321XLR, A220 and Boeing 737 aircraft, which operate on the carrier's domestic network as well as to New Zealand and the Pacific Islands.

High-tiered members will receive complimentary access to Qantas economy plus.

"This is an evolution of our economy offering and delivers more choice for our customers while recognising our most loyal frequent flyers with expanded benefits, in the areas we know they value the most," said Qantas Group CEO Vanessa Hudson.

APT's best month

APT Travel Group has recorded its biggest-ever sales month in Oct, with three of the company's four highest sales days on record taking place last week.

The impressive growth was driven largely by APT and Travelmarvel's Classic European journeys, boosted by new ships, and strong early-season bookings for 2026.

"It is very pleasing to see the areas where the business has made significant investments new ships in Europe, Vietnam and now Egypt plus significant investment in upgrading our Kimberely lodges and our new partnerships with Seabourn and Heritage Expeditions - is fuelling our growth," APT Travel Group CEO David Cox said.



At the same time, the Qantas Group announced the appointment of Alison Watkins as an independent Non-Executive Director from Mar 2026, as part of its ongoing board renewal.

Watkins is a member of the Reserve Bank Monetary Policy Board, a director of CSL, Wesfarmers and Chancellor of the University of Tasmania. JM

10% of US flights cut

FROM today, thousands of flights will be cut across the US due to the government shutdown (TD 10 Oct), which is now in its 37th day and has so far cost the nation's travel industry around US\$4 billion (A\$6.2 billion).

The FAA has ordered air traffic to be reduced by 10% at 40 of the nation's busiest airports including the popular gateways of Hawaii and Dallas for Aussies flying to the US - to ensure travel safety and help relieve pressure amid traffic controller shortages.


United Airlines has confirmed its long-haul international and hub-to-hub services will not be impacted by the schedule reduction, and is offering refunds to customers travelling during this period if they do not wish to fly, even if their flight is not impacted.

Qantas services to the US have not been impacted so far.

GREECE'S largest carrier. Aegean Airlines, has announced the appointment of Aviation Online as its general sales agent in Australia and New Zealand.

The agreement, which also includes Aegean's subsidiary airline Olympic Air, will give local travel advisors direct access to the airline's expanding network, supporting the growing demand for travel to Greece and the broader Mediterranean region.

JQ's new Sunny service



JETSTAR has announced the launch of direct flights from Sunshine Coast Airport to Singapore via Bali.

Beginning Mar 2026, the new service marks the first direct connection between the Sunshine Coast and Southeast Asia.

The new Jetstar service will operate three times per week using the airline's Airbus A321LR aircraft, offering more than 70,000 seats annually.

"The new route will strengthen the Sunshine Coast's position as a global gateway for Queensland and enhance access for international visitors looking to explore the Sunshine Coast, Noosa and the wider region," said Sunshine Coast Airport Chief Executive Officer Chris Mills.

To celebrate, Jetstar is offering one-way sale fares from Sunshine Coast to Bali (Denpasar), available via jetstar.com from \$199 until 1pm AEDT tomorrow. JM

QR sells CX stake

QATAR Airways has sold its entire 9.7% stake in Cathay Pacific Airways for HK\$6.97 billion (approx. A\$1.4b), marking its complete exit from Hong Kong's flagship carrier after eight years.

Cathay Pacific will repurchase the shareholding through a buyback at HK\$10.84 (A\$2.10) per share - roughly a 4% discount on its last closing share price.

The Doha-based carrier had bought the stake in Nov 2017, making it the third-largest shareholder in Cathay after Swire Pacific and Air China.

Qatar CEO Badr Mohammed Al-Meer said the exit reflected the company's disciplined portfolio strategy and would allow the company to position itself for long-term growth.

The carriers said they will continue their partnership through the oneworld Alliance.

IR's new booking system

INTERNATIONAL Rail (IR) has launched its new online booking system for the Rest of the World rail services, now available to travel agents across Australia and New Zealand.

Advisors can request rail bookings directly through the website, streamlining access to Portugal, Norway, Sweden and Poland in Europe, China and South Korea in Asia, and Morocco in Africa.

The new system offers an efficient, time-saving solution for agents - who previously could only access these destinations' rail services via email - as well as lower fares and booking fees and commission on online bookings.

Bookings can be made up to four months in advance, with tickets issued 60 days prior to travel or once ticketing opens.

"At International Rail, we listen closely to our trade partners and continuously work to deliver the tools and services they seek," said



Jonathan Hume (pictured), owner and Chief Executive Officer of International Rail.

"The launch of our Rest of World booking tab is another example of how we're responding to demand and expanding our product offering to make European rail even more accessible and efficient for agents across Australia and New Zealand."

The announcement marks a significant expansion of International Rail's digital platform and follows the release of its Japan and US rail system earlier this year (TD 17 Jun). JM

QF's Sunrise takes shape

IMAGES of Qantas' first Project Sunrise aircraft have been released this week, as the A350-1000ULR has completed several production milestones at the Airbus manufacturing facility in Toulouse.

The plane is set to become part of the world's longest commercial flight, connecting Australia's east coast non-stop to London and New York for the first time across a 22-hour journey.

This week, it will be transferred to a new hangar, with engines and flight test instruments installed, before it starts an extensive flight program next year.

"Project Sunrise will not only overcome the tyranny of distance, it will fundamentally change the way our customers travel the world," said Qantas Group Chief Executive Officer Vanessa Hudson.

"These flights will cut up to four hours off the journey and



transform how people experience ultra long-haul travel, through science backed design to minimise jetlag and maximise wellbeing," she added.

The first of 12 new aircraft is planned for delivery in late 2026, with the first commercial services starting in the first half of 2027.

However, Project Sunrise was originally set to introduce its nonstop routes around the middle of this year, although it was hit with delays due to supply chain issues and the redesign of fuel tanks (*TD* 27 Mar). *JHM*

"We don't just talk about partnership, we live it."




The vibrant livery features on an Airbus A220 aircraft (**pictured** inset), which will be seen in the skies and at several destinations across Canada and the US. *JM*
